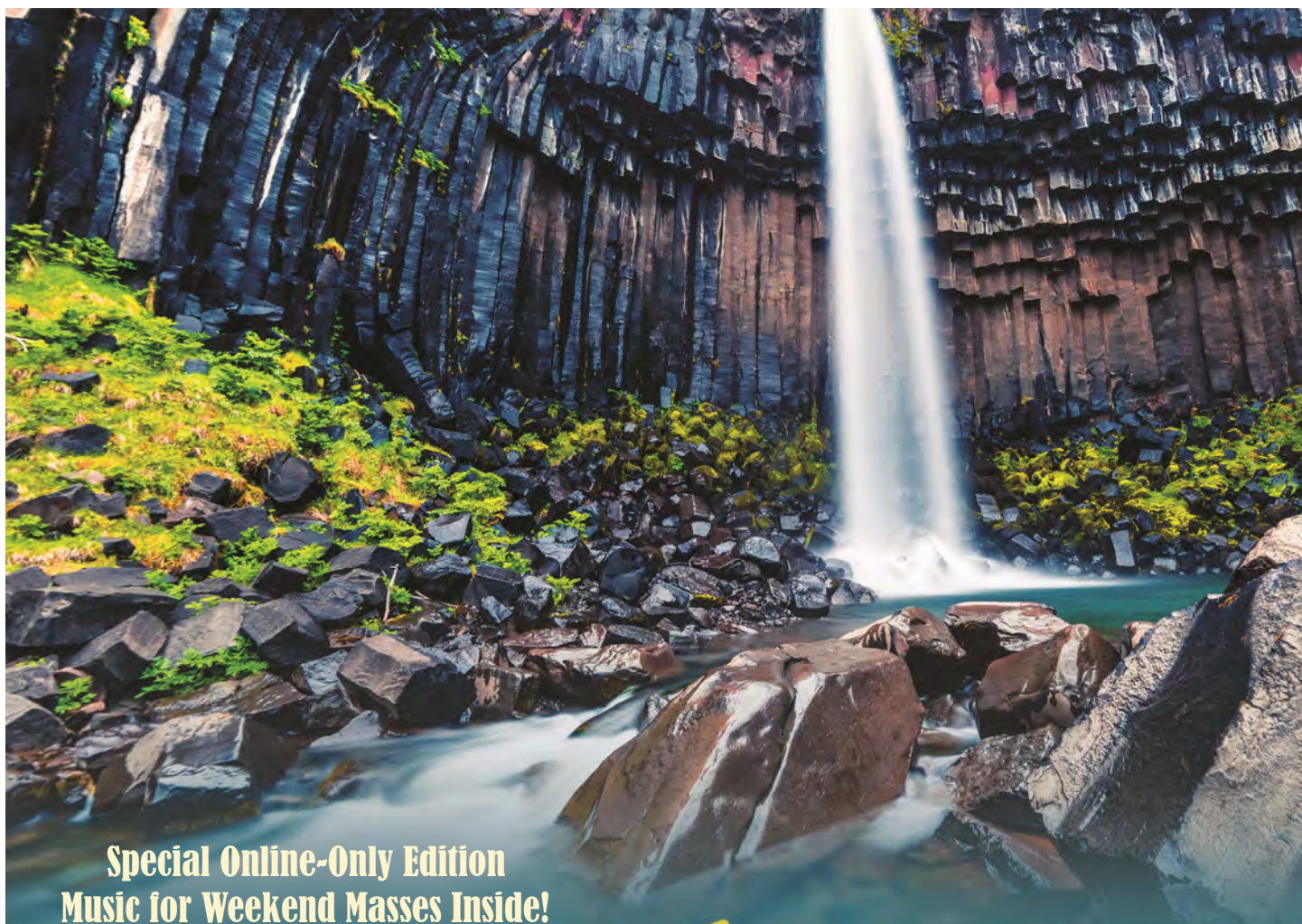

As you may know, we have postponed several trips this year due to civil unrest and protests against the government. These events paralyzed travel and the movement of critical goods and supplies in the country inhibiting our ability to do our work in Bassin Zim.

While the civil unrest was the focus earlier in the year, COVID 19 has presented a new challenge. It is a dire situation as the Haitian people have struggled to obtain the proper materials to protect themselves with face coverings and sanitizing stations. HaitiReach donated masks, hand washing stations and printed education materials to train the community on proper hand sanitizing and distancing procedures.

Our Lady of Fatima needs our help now more than

ever, and we want them to know that we have not abandoned them but are continuing our commitment to help them, even as the mode of that help changes.

Mission is not merely something we do; it is who we are as a Christian people. It is an attitude that we bring to our brothers and sisters of Our Lady of Fatima Parish as an outpouring of God's grace showing them, we are truly one Body of Christ. 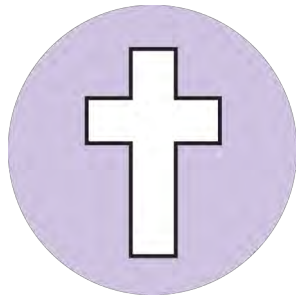

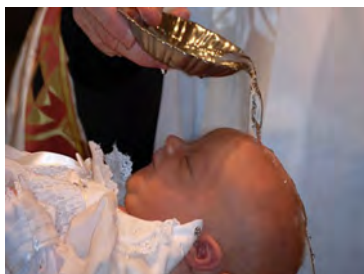
