Please keep Bishop Swain in your prayers as he continues his time in the hospital. As I type this our diocesan chancellor said that Bishop is stable and lucid after having experienced some stroke-like symptoms. To help him attain the rest he needs the Bishop requests at this time no visitors.

Also, keep in your prayers the children from both parishes who will soon be making their First Holy Communion. First Communion Masses will be:

Soon there will be several events to honor the centennial of the dedication of Cathedral of St. Joseph. There will be a Mass on May 1st, 2019 at 7pm at the Cathedral. (The first of May is the feast day of St. Joseph the Worker, patron of our diocese). Bishop Swain was supposed to be the main celebrant of that Mass but with his recent illness, it probably will be the rector of the Cathedral, Fr. J. P. Morgan fulfilling that role.
