

I wish to say a big thank you to so many in both parishes that have prayed for me and assisted me in various ways. I know you'll do the same for your Father Lawrence!

I will be donating three copies of a book I authored (a little less than twenty years ago): "The Pope and the Holocaust", to each of the parishes. I ask you donate ten dollars to the parish to purchase a copy, if you wish. The book is a defense of Pope Pius XII against those who slander him and say he did not help the Jews during World War II. He certainly did and was a heroic and holy man. While I continue to stand by that essential part of the book, from further research I now have serious questions about the authenticity of the story of massive gassings at the internment camps run by the Germans. The "six million" figure is certainly bogus propaganda. In fact since the late 1800's and decades leading up to the war, there are many major physical newspapers from all over the western world that promote Jewish propaganda about "six million" Jews being under threat/danger in eastern Europe, in Russia. Keep in mind that the Jewish mindset is influenced by the "Talmud" and "Kabbalah" which both allow for lying (and other evils) against Gentiles (whom they consider on the level of cattle and are to be slaves for them). The Jewish mindset that has rejected Christ and reflected in some of their beliefs in the errors/black magic of numerology and the like. Much new physical evidence shows it didn't happen and we must keep in mind the Communists were the ones to reach most of the camps that held work prisoners during the last days of World War II. The supposed gassing buildings have been shown to be lacking in infrastructure to seal off, then vent off the gasses safely. Keep in mind that Germans were excellent engineers and wouldn't have used buildings that become a danger to themselves. Nor were there precautions regarding the electric wiring of the so-called "gas chambers". One spark would have blown those buildings to bits. We are all familiar with the cremation stations. However, there were only about one dozen of them at Auschwitz and that was supposed to be a camp were over a million were gassed. But using math and science, it becomes clear that the Germans (who always struggled to produce enough fuel for their war efforts) did not have sufficient fuels to do cremations of bodies at the pace that we are supposed to believe happened. It would take hours with tons of burning coal to cremate one body. The Germans simply didn't have it for such purposes. They extracted the fuel value of coal to make their tank and plane fuel. What was left over was coke which burns with great difficulty. Nor would it have been possible to burn bodies in the swampy grounds of Auschwitz. It has been shown that it can't be done. Keep in mind, Communists were (and still are) master propagandists along with Jews who had deep animus against Germany, so they had plenty of motive to paint such an evil story and we were all too ready to believe the worst after years of propaganda within our own homeland as well. Over the years, Jews and Israel have received about one TRILLION dollars in German currency equivalent in "war reparations". Recall too FDR was an admirer of Stalin and it ended up that his administration has been proven to have been riddled with pro-Communists and even Communist spies! We were told the Russians (Communists) were good allies during the war and for a short time after the war until it became clear to most Americans they really weren't. Did many persons die at those Nazi run camps? Yes, mainly due to typhus and/or starvation as things collapsed for the German side in the last year of the war. Red Cross records of the time tallied about 300,000 internment camp deaths. The official Jewish annual encyclopedia showed no significant change in European Jewish population of 1948 statistics compared to pre-war statistics. Also, remember, that the U.S. had its own internment camps during WWII incarcerating Japanese Americans. Also research about Allied High Command murderous treatment of German POWs after the war under the heading of "Other Losses". After a long cover-up the truth is slowly coming to light by diligent researchers that our Allied High Command purposely put German POWs under a manipulated category to avoid Geneva Convention rules just so that they could expose them to the elements in open air camps and slowly starved them to death. German citizens were not allowed to throw food over the barbed wire fences. And there were purposeful insufficient rations given to the German former soldiers by Allied forces even though after the war, the Allies had plentiful supplies. It's ugly to think about it, but we need to know the truth. Also, don't forget and learn more about the Communist "gulags" in which many millions died in Russian Siberia.
