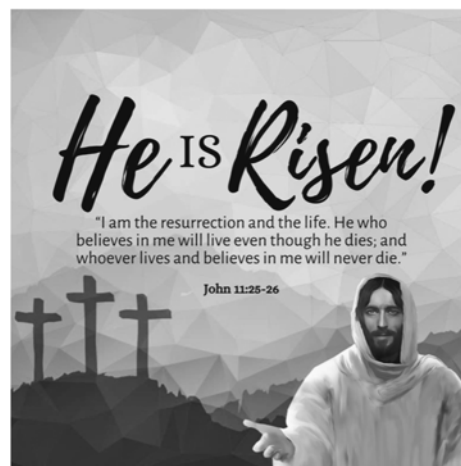

Christ
is
Risen!

I would imagine we've all had the experience of marking our location at the point of a specific event: "Where were you?" Where were you on 9/11? Where were you when JFK was shot? Where were you when we landed on the moon? Where were you...(fill in the blank)?

The other day, I heard Johnny Cash's rendition of *Were You There (When They Crucified My Lord)*? We've all heard and know the song. We sing it every year on Good Friday. It's about putting us in a specific place and time and recognizing the fact that we were there – not physically, ourselves – but in the heart of Jesus.

The Crucifixion – for many of the people who *were* there – was not the extraordinarily significant event we (Christ's followers) understand it to be. Crucifixion was a regular practice of execution in the

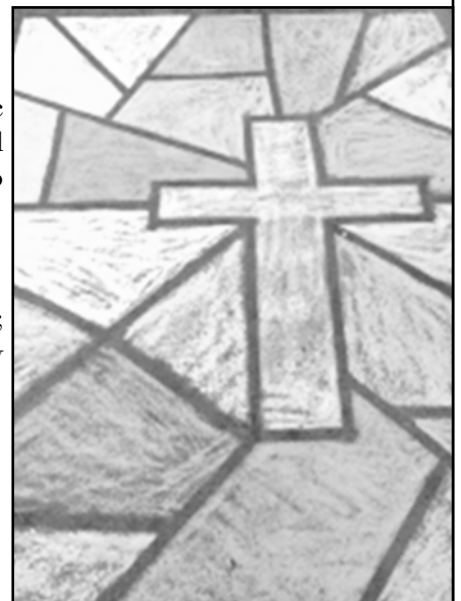
time of Jesus. The day and manner Jesus died was not much different than any other day for those condemned to die. However, in the case of Jesus' death, it's not the day or means of death that brings us to that place and time; it's the person, it's the "who" that makes all the difference...in his death and his RESURRECTION!

Last year (for the Easter bulletin), I commented on the Cross (see picture below) and how we were feeling fragmented from each other but, through it all - there was light, there was hope. There is no doubt this past year has been a tough one. We've been through a lot over the last year, but we have also come so far. Last year, we were locked down, classes were interrupted by all sorts of issues, trying to learn through (and about) video conferencing was a nightmare, etc. This year, since August, we have had uninterrupted instruction (in-person, five days a week); the school has not shut down even for one day, and we have learned to overcome challenges with (not in spite of) technology and innovation. My guess is in the years to come, our students will be asked, "Where were you the year of the COVID-19 pandemic?" Of course, I hope they gladly and gratefully say, "I was at St. Egbert School." However, what I pray they also say is, "I was with Jesus." Because, more important than "where I was" is "who was with me."

Given this reality - the fact we have come (are coming) through the pandemic together, as a community of faith – we can see ourselves as "a people God means to have for himself; it is [ours] to proclaim the exploits of the God who has called [us] out of darkness into his marvelous light." *1 Pt 2:9*

May God bless us and continue to bring us out of the darkness of the pandemic; and, through the Resurrection, bring us out of the darkness of death, so we may proclaim: He is Risen! He is Risen, Indeed!
