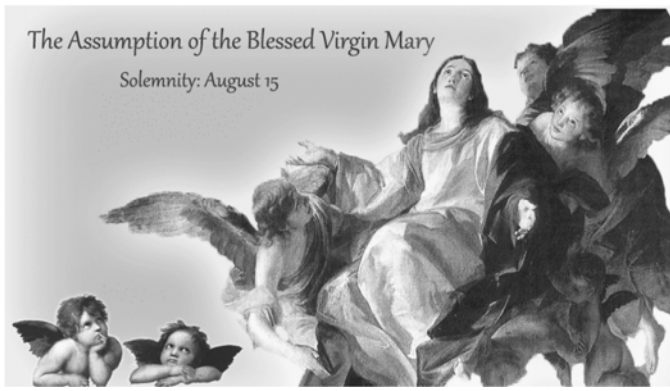

Dear Ones,

There, but for the grace of God, go I. My summer week away was a reminder to me of the frailty we humans have. My friends since 1976 are two retired university professors. They are both in memory-care sections of the St. Joseph of the Pines retirement facility in Southern Pines. They still knew who I was. Next time I see them, I don't know if they will. Three out of their four kids have changed their lives to accommodate visiting their parents from Raleigh, Augusta and Omaha. I need to kick the one who's missing. Since I've known them all since they were in high school and I presided at each of their weddings, I feel I have some authority and responsibility. How do I caringly and respectfully kick butt? Say a prayer for me.

My friend Sister Barbara Marie had 6+ hours of spine surgery which diverted me from visiting Old Salem. She and I are of an age. This was her first surgery, her first overnight in a hospital. After the operation, her surgeon said that the original damage to her spine happened during the first Bush Administration. He asked her if she had an enormously high pain threshold or if she just had a ferocious iron will to keep moving. She smiled at him (she has both!)

A religious author, Louis Evely, wrote: "An unmistakable sign of the presence of God is that you will be led where you did not plan to go." In visiting these friends I was able, through them, to experience the presence of God. I give thanks for my time away; I am thankful to have come home to the sparkling new floors of the Parish House where, today (Monday), I don't have to take off my shoes when I come in the door.

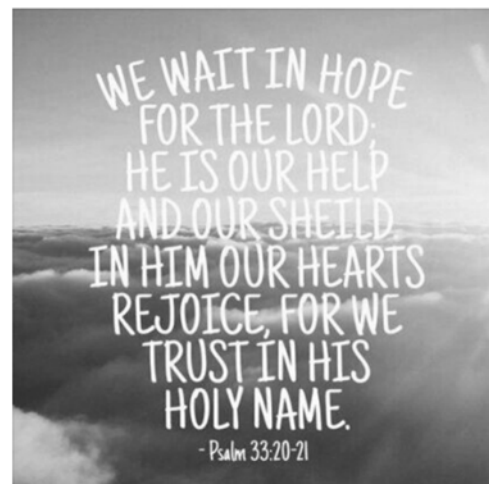
