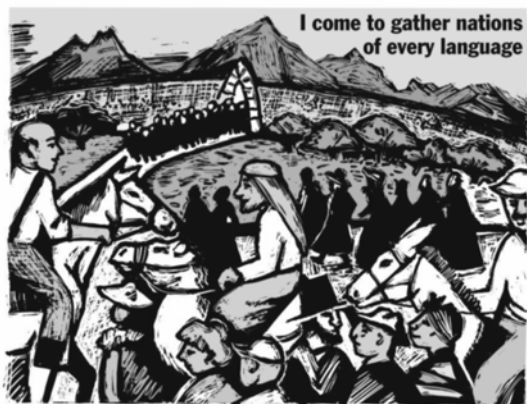

Someone asked me about prayer resources. Looking back, I did write about “iBreviary” last March. The iBreviary is a wonderful app that is a great resource for viewing the daily Mass readings and the psalms as they are broken up so that all 150 of them are read over a four-week month. It is free but they invite donations on the site (they do not chase you down with annoying reminders. Ever.) When you hit the cloud symbol it always asks you are you sure that you want to download the readings/psalms of the day. I always hit yes. I’m not a gamer (I use my cell phone for calls and to read emails) so I’m not worried about filling up some section of the ether.

As the school year begins, it is a good time to nurture our lives of prayer. Take turns saying a blessing before meals. Just before bedtime, call to mind friends and family who are needful, then say the Lord’s Prayer together. “Where two or more are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them.” Prayer can help us to be better people and better families. ## Ladies' Guild

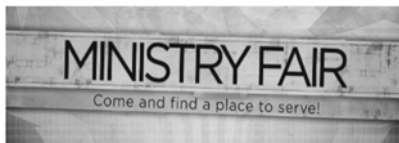
