Our Gospel reading for this weekend is all about forgiveness. “How many times must I forgive my brother, seven times?” To which Jesus replies, “not seven times but seventy times seven times.” In the Jewish word, seven was considered one of the “perfect” numbers (they had several), so, in essence, Jesus is giving them a sense of “infinity.” They must ALWAYS forgive. Now couple that with last week’s gospel, which told us “what you forgive on earth will be forgiven in heaven, and what you retain on earth will be retained in heaven.” Putting these together, we can come to the conclusion that our ever-loving God is ever-forgiving. Throughout history, people have been trying to determine if there is an unforgivable sin. Through this scripture, we are assured that there is NOTHING that God will not forgive.

### FORGIVENESS

Nearly ten years before, a son and father had parted ways when the business they shared went bankrupt. The son blamed the father. They did not speak to each other again.

Then the father became seriously ill. The mother called the son and told him he had better come soon. The son walked sheepishly into the hospital room. The father motioned his son to him and whispered: "Did you ever think you could do anything that would keep me from loving you?"

Resentment and anger are foul things, the first reading from Sirach tells us. Remember the last things. Stop hating. Live by the commandments. As St. Paul writes to the Romans, we are to live for the Lord and die for the Lord.

Jesus' parable in today's Gospel reminds us of God's compassion. The immense sin of humanity has been forgiven and stricken from the record. We are to forgive others in the same way.
