2020-2021 CORI

If you are a volunteer you must fill out a $\underline{\mathbf{C}}$ riminal $\underline{\mathbf{O}}$ ffender $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$ ecord $\underline{\mathbf{I}}$ nformation Form every year.

The Archdiocese of Boston requires all clergy, all parish staff (full and part-time), and all volunteers (18 years of age and older) who minister to or have the potential for unmonitored access to children, youth, elderly, or the disabled will undergo an annual CORI check.

No matter what you volunteer to do, if your duties are carried out on parish property, or under the parish name, you must be CORI-ed every year.

What Does *Vespers* Mean?



Vespers means "evening," a reference to dusk when devout Jews daily offered a Temple lamp-lighting prayer to God; Jews also prayed Temple Lauds at pre-dawn. The Jewish Apostles and their Christian disciples formalized these 2 oral prayer sequences by rotating psalms, antiphons,

the Lord's Prayer, and short teachings from Wisdom or the Prophets or from St. Paul's epistles. Eventually, Tertullian (3rd cent.) added Noon Prayer, then Benedict (6th cent.) added 4 more hours, each of which coincided with a suffering of Jesus in the last 24 hours of His life. This extension, which became known as The Divine Office for monastics and cloistered female religious, fulfilled Jesus' command: "pray always" (Luke 8:1) and Psalm 11:164: "Seven times daily I praise Thee." By the 12th century, the 4 hefty texts of the Liturgy of Hours were often abbreviated to a single common book of Christian Prayer called the Breviary. With 16th cent. innovations in printing and with the 1963 Vatican II call for the laity to exercise their Baptismal priestly function, all Christendom was invited into psalmody and sacred silences. This antique Song of the Church spans generations, continents, cultures, and time zones in a daily continuous chant of right praise to God: Lauds, Prime, Terce, Sext, None, Vespers, and Compline (Add Nightwatch [Vigil] for the insomniacs.).



October 11 Vespers at IC: That Sunday's Gospel mentions a wedding. For Vespers that evening, led by Deacon John Moranski—2 magnificent calla lily wedding arrangements flanked 3 illustrated 14th c replicas of Vespers. Twenty HRIC parishioners experienced this ancient evening Prayer of the Church. All are welcome. No experience necessary.




"Icy" the pelican was on hand for the fun, *pictured*.


