



### From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I thought I would take a moment to share a few updates with you from across the Collaborative.





and so far have not seen any extraordinary uptick in viral cases. Other than requiring face masks for all indoor RE programs this fall, we have no new guidance from the Archdiocese or the state. Our parish policy remains that face masks are recommended (but not required) for all parishioners for any indoor liturgy or activity. We continue to monitor the latest updates for any new guidance or requirements. To my knowledge, we have not experienced any outbreaks of COVID or any other diseases related to in-person Mass attendance this past year.

At this time, parish Mass attendance is hovering at about 50-60% of what it was pre-COVID. We are seeing a slow, but steady, increase in Mass participation, with the parking lots slowly starting to fill to capacity at most Masses. Choral singing and full music programs are underway in both parishes. Hymnals have been returned to the pews. Parish finances are a little ahead of attendance due to parishioners utilizing mail-in and electronic contributions. Grand Annual Collections are underway in both Collaborative parishes. Updated financial reports were mailed with the Grand Annual request letter. Both parishes met or exceeded our Catholic Appeal assessments that were set by the Archdiocese this spring, although we do not expect that they will be receiving any excess monies back this year. Given the circumstances, this is still quite a success and a testament to people's generosity in the midst of the pandemic. If the COVID numbers continue the way they are now, it is my hope to return to greater youth participation (Altar Serving and Children's Choir) to parish liturgies in January.

Recent repair work was done on the St. Ann campus to repair the crumbling retaining wall behind the church and replace the lower hall access door. Also, the gutters were replaced and the eves and upper trim painted on the IC Pastoral Center Building. The IC rectory was given a muchneeded paint job this fall along with the IC parking lot being re-sealed. As part of the Capital Campaign projects, the roof on the Nativity rectory/office building was replaced as well. The generous amount of rainfall in recent months has kept the grass guite green and healthy among all of our parish properties as well. I hope that it looked good for the recent Viewpoint filming that was undertaken as part of an IC School promotion. I am very excited to see all the footage, especially the drone shots! The school Mass that was filmed was very energetic and exciting! The Viewpoint segment that will include IC School is scheduled to air in January on PBS.

In addition to the Grand Annual collections, we will be starting some longer-term fundraising in both parishes later this fall. At Holy Redeemer, we will be raising money to replace the furnaces in both churches with new HVAC systems. There is some Capital Campaign money left over to begin this project, but more will be needed to complete it. At IC, we will be raising funds to completely replace and

# **Born Alive Signature Campaign**

Earlier this year, the Massachusetts legislature enacted a pro-death abortion law which is one of the most radical in the country.



In addition to other horrific provisions, this new

law removed the legal protection that had been provided for babies that were born alive despite having been targeted for death in abortion.

In order to reverse this law, volunteers will be outside at some of our Masses to collect signatures on a pro-life petition. The petition states: "Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, if a child is born alive, all reasonable steps, in keeping with good medical practice, shall be taken to preserve the life of the child born alive."

The first step in putting this matter before Massachusetts voters is to collect over 80,000 signatures on the petition. Please sign the petition to protect the most vulnerable among us.

# IC Haiti Update

On August 14, our friends in Haiti were forced to overcome yet another life challenge when a large earthquake occurred in the southern peninsula near Les Cayes. Different than the earthquake which struck Port-au-Prince in 2010, this time the major seismic event epicenter occurred only about 20 miles from our school in Puit Chacha. Fortunately, our school did not sustain any major damage, which can be attributed to the seismic building standards used during the construction in 2012. Although the earthquake greatly impacted many communities on the southern peninsula, our school was able to resume classes and continue with the important lunch program.

It appears that our catchment community, which includes Fond-des-Blancs, has been able to deal with the latest disruption to their "normal" life and continue on. From my perspective and what I witnessed first-hand during my trips to Haiti, the philosophy of most of the people is to address adversity, make adjustments, and carry on with life while never losing hope that it will get better. I am pleased to report that our school community is resilient and moving forward with the 21-22 school year as planned. We are making some improvements to the building and kitchen area. More and more students are taking advantage of our secondary school scholarship program. If everything goes well, we will graduate our first Chacha student through the 13th grade of high school next year. It has been another challenging time for our friends in Haiti, but we should be inspired by their resilience and learn to always maintain hope regardless of the circumstances.

Despite the many obstacles to fundraising during the pandemic, the constant generosity of IC parishioners and other supporters has allowed IC Haiti to fund the entire 2021–22 school year budget. In addition, we are making a sizeable donation to St. Boniface Hospital in Fond-des-Blancs to help to defray the cost for the construction of new operating rooms there. For this, our Board of Directors is most grateful to all who have contributed financially and to all who have supported this ministry with prayer. May Our Lord continue to bless our commitment to our brothers and sisters in Haiti.

I see Haiti, I see hope.
