2020-2021 CORI

If you are a volunteer you must fill out a <u>Criminal</u> <u>Offender</u> <u>Record</u> <u>Information</u> Form every year.

The Archdiocese of Boston requires all clergy, all parish staff (full and part-time), and all volunteers (18 years of age and older) who minister to or have the potential for unmonitored access to children, youth, elderly, or the disabled will undergo an annual CORI check.

No matter what you volunteer to do, if your duties are carried out on parish property, or under the parish name, you must be CORI-ed every year.

At-Home Retreat

Please join us for a Directed At-Home Retreat.

Staying on the interior path in these turbulent times of social upheaval, uncharted health challenges, unwanted change, powerlessness, loss, limitations, separation from loved ones, uncertainty, and anxiety may be difficult as you struggle with life's daily challenges and the present chaos and uncertainty, Yet, the very darkness we seek to avoid, if embraced with faith, may present opportunities to experience God's unconditional, ever present love within, sustaining and transforming us through our suffering by connecting us to hope that flows from God. This hope is not tied to good or future outcomes. This hope sustains us in the present regardless of external circumstances or conditions.

During this five-week retreat you will have opportunities for three individual one-hour sessions of spiritual direction by phone or zoom scheduled at your convenience.

Retreat Packet material will support learning through teachings from the works of Richard Rohr, *Wisdom Path*; Order-Disorder-Reorder; Cynthia Bourgeault, *Mystical Hope;* Paul Coutinho, SJ., *Sacred Darkness* and others as wells as poems, prayers, and guestions for reflection.

During retreat time, through prayer, reading, learning, reflection, group sharing, and individual spiritual direction you will be aided to name and explore your own experience of present darkness and challenges to staying on the interior path and guided to become more aware of the inner path to hope.

This retreat is designed to be affordable, convenient, and safe. It will begin with a group Zoom meeting to discuss the retreat's theme and prepare participants for our interior journey through darkness to hope The group will meet again during the third week with Zoom to share reflections and responses to material read and support each other as the retreat continues. The closing session will provide participants an opportunity to share the fruits of retreat, continued desires, questions, and responses to embracing the darkness and opening to the hope that holds us now.


