Mobile and Email Phishing Scam

There have been reports of both email and texting scams happening within parishes of the diocese this past week. Parishioners have received text messages and emails claiming to be from their pastor asking for assistance. The emails and texts were sent from unknown accounts. However, the use of the pastor's name caused individuals to believe it was, in fact, "Father" who was reaching out to them. Unfortunately some parishioners have lost money to this scam as they were tricked into purchasing gift cards for a fake cause. At the encouragement of the SD Attorney General's Office, we urge all parishioners to be mindful: Priests/parishes will never ask for money or gift cards via text message or email. (Further, Fr. Christopher has texting disabled on his phone since he does not care for it. So if you receive a text from Fr. Christopher it is either a scam or his evil twin!)

If you receive a text or email asking for money or gift cards, you should always call the parish office to verify. You can also report it to the SD Attorney General's office at 1-800-300-1986. Their office is investigating this scam.
