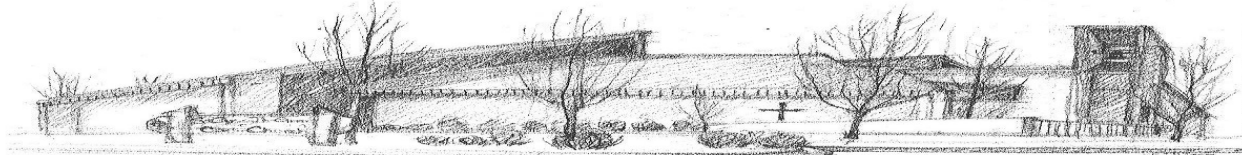

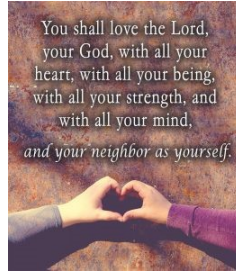

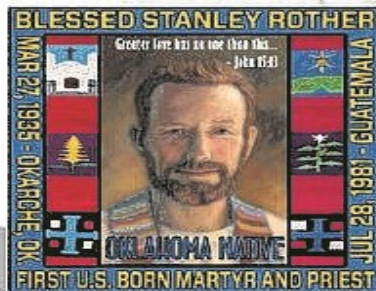


## Rother Feast Day at Resurrection Cemetery
