His ministry is faithful to the magisterium. His prayer for individuals is powerfully accentuated by the Holy Spirit’s gift of word of knowledge and healing. God has used Frank to bring healing of body, mind and soul to tens of thousands of persons.

CORNELIUS

The Acts of the Apostles tell us of the meeting between Saint Peter and a Roman centurion named Cornelius. At the time of the Apostles, the Jews were ruled by the Romans. The Romans stationed soldiers in the Jewish lands.

A centurion was an officer who commanded a "century" of soldiers, which was composed of about eighty men. The picture shows a centurion in armor.


