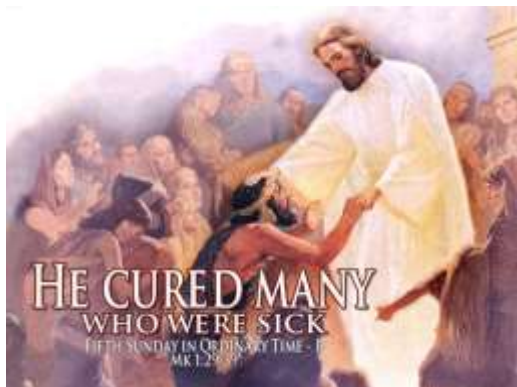

UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK *in re The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y.* Case No. 20-10322. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y., (“Diocese”) filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”). The Bankruptcy Court has established August 14, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the “Bar Date”). If you have a claim against the Diocese, including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date. Please visit <https://case.stretto.com/diocesefofbuffalo> or call 855-292-7696 for more information on how to file your proof of claim. **IF YOU DO NOT TIMELY FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM, YOU MAY FORFEIT YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE ON ANY PLAN OF REORGANIZATION AND TO SHARE IN ANY DISTRIBUTIONS TO CREDITORS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIOCESE’S CHAPTER 11 CASE.**

Lenten Suggestions

Lent will begin February 17th (Ash Wednesday), only 11 days away. Here are some suggestions for making the Lenten season spiritually profitable:

PRAYER: Eucharist (Sunday, daily)
Morning and evening prayer (Chapel daily)
Sacrament of Penance
Devotions (Stations of the Cross; Lenten Booklet)

FASTING: Fridays of Lenten season (Abstinence, simple meal)

CHARITY: Personal, private, Catholic Charities

P.S. - Bring your palms from last year before Ash Wednesday be used for ashes this year.

P.P.S. - Just a reminder that this year, because of COVID-19, ashes will be sprinkled on your head instead of being placed on the forehead. FYI, this is the usual practice in Europe.
