PROPHETIC WORDS FROM BISHOP JAMES A. McNULTY, D.D. BISHOP OF BUFFALO 1963 – 1972

On May 23, 1953, at a civic reception in Paterson, New Jersey, welcoming him as newly-appointed Bishop of that diocese, Bishop McNulty spoke the following words:

“We need badly today vigorous impatience and wise resourcefulness... to restrain godless influences which corrode the sanctity of the home and destroy the edifice of our national life.

...our city, our nation, can prosper and be at peace only when we live within the framework of the law; where we acknowledge the supremacy of God and respect the dignity of every human being as a child of God.

May these basic truths, upon which our beloved nation has thrived, be our firm conviction today.”
