Pastor's Page

"The Kingdom of God is at hand, repent and believe in the Gospel".

How are we to understand "kingdom" today as Christians, living in what we call democracies, where we have a president and governors? We tend to reject kings and queens, dukes and duchesses. But, if we are Christians, we cannot reject the words of Jesus when he teaches in terms of the Kingdom of God. Should we speak of the presidency of God being at hand? Should we speak of the government of God being at hand?

I think the answer lies in observing how the evangelist Mark, whose version of the Gospel we are using this year, presents Jesus as an authority, whether we want to call him king or president or governor. Without a doubt he is an authority, or, we should say, he is THE authority.

Jesus is God incarnate

He is co creator with the Father and the Holy Spirit. Under his guiding hand our universe functions: planet earth turning on it's axes every 24 hours giving us daylight and darkness, planet earth tilts to the north and then to the south, giving us our 4 seasons, and it possesses a favorable atmosphere that results in fertile soil and a vast variety of plant and animal life almost beyond our imagination. Our own persons are a marvel of talents, skin colors and personalities. What a marvel, and this vast creation all comes through his authority. The book of Genesis states: "God looked at everything he had made and he

found it very good". Today with the help of science, we would say God did it all through a process of evolution and not in a 24 hour period, but we would still repeat: "He found it very good" and He still finds it very good today. He is a generous and wise authority, who doesn't do it for himself, making himself rich, sitting on a throne with slaves all around him, but he does it for us, his family.

During his earthly life Jesus lived among all he had created as another human being, in a family where there was understanding and mutual responsibility.

Once he had begun his public life, he was always acting as a team with his Father and the Holy Spirit. After helping someone in need with a miracle, he went off, not to be alone with himself but with his Father. In his teaching, he didn't go alone, but with the apostles and sent out a group of 72, in pairs, to announce the kingdom of God. He was not at the service only of his relatives and friends, but also of other with whom he came in contact, of social rank like a temple authority (Mk. 5, 22) and of a humble woman (Mk. 7, 24).

He said to Simon and Andrew "Come after me" and He says to you and me today "Come after me". He says to us: exercise authority as I have done, in the different professions that we practice: as husbands and wives, as parents, as priests and responsible single persons. In teaching, agriculture, commerce, and the many other professions we feel called to. Are we exercising authority well as

God does in Jesus? Pope Francis in his encyclical *Brothers and Sisters All*, indicates that we follow Jesus by having a heart open to the whole world (FT128).

"Never has it been more evident than in our own day, that the world is interconnected by globalization in the political and economic order" (FT138). "Life without fraternal generosity becomes a form of frenetic commerce, in which we weigh what we give and what we get back". "On the other hand, God (the King) gives freely..." "We received life freely, we paid nothing for it". "Consequently, all of us are able to give without expecting anything in return..." (FT140). "We need to have a global outlook to save us from petty provincialism" (FT142) "accompanied by a process of education that promotes the value of one's love for his neighbor" (FT151).

The Kingdom of God, the presidency of God, the authority of God has the possibility of becoming a world reality like never before in history. And you and I, as followers of Jesus, are part of bringing it about.

First Reading **Jonah 3: 1-5, 10**

The word of the LORD came to Jonah, saying: "Set out for the great city of Nineveh, and announce to it the message that I will tell you." So Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD'S bidding. Now Nineveh was an enormously large city; it took three days to go through it. Jonah began his journey through the city, and had gone but a single day's walk announcing, "Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed, "when the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth.

When God saw by their actions how they turned from their evil way, he repented of the evil that he had threatened to do to them; he did not carry it out.

Gospel **Mark 1: 14-20**

After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

As he passed by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea; they were fishermen. Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Then they abandoned their nets and followed him. He walked along a little farther and saw James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They too were in a boat mending their nets. Then he called them. So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him.

One of the characteristics of Everyday Stewardship is to be committed — to persevere daily in a way of life acknowledging that everything belongs to God.

I know, I know. Easier said than done.

Just ask Zebedee. It's quite an image we get from the Gospel, after all. "So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him."

There was Zebedee, about his business, mending nets with his two sons, who were undoubtedly his best workers — they had to have been more dedicated than the hired men, who worked for wages rather than for family. And in an instant off they go, following this strange man.

I don't know about you, but if my kids left me on a hot summer day to finish the lawn by myself, I wouldn't be too happy.

But Zebedee must have been someone quite special. Perhaps he realized that his sons didn't belong to him — not really. They belonged to God, and from the beginning of time, it had been appointed that they would be among the first disciples of Christ. He passed, he called, they followed, and Zebedee obliged. He simply went back to mending his nets, I imagine.

Zebedee already understood what St. Teresa of Calcutta would say millennia later: "Give until it hurts."

"You're wasting my time." "I've done so much for her; she owes me this." How often do we think things, and even people and relationships, belong to us? The truth is none of them do. We must be ready, as Zebedee was, to surrender them to God when He comes walking past.
