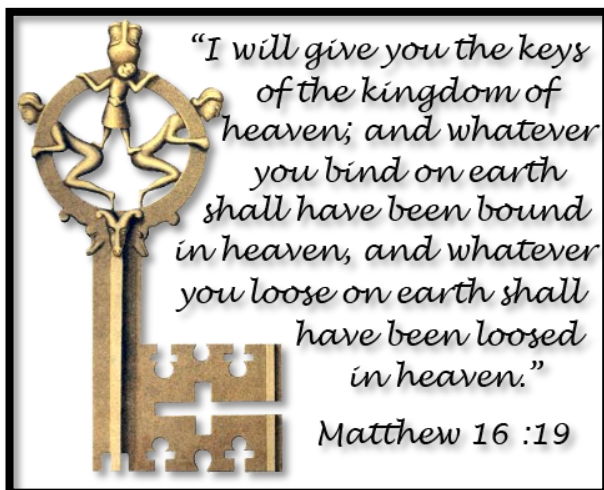


CCD & Youth Group
