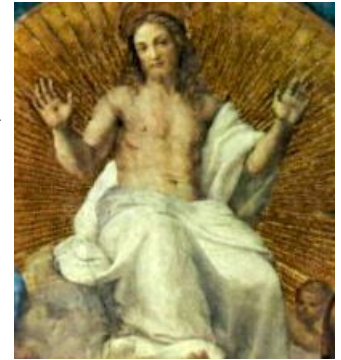

But Christ's Ascension is the pledge of our own.
