MIDWEEK REFRESHER


READ: John 10: 11-18

<u>REFLECT</u>: Jesus' claim to be the true shepherd, the only pastor, has nothing idyllic about it. It completes his break with the mercenary religious leaders in whose eyes the sheep matter little. "I myself will pasture my sheep; I myself wills give them rest, says the Lord God. The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal shepherding them rightly." (Ezk. 34:15-16) This is God's way of acting, and the way of Christ, who gave his life for those the Father entrusted to him.

Many do not appreciate being compared to a flock of sheep. Nevertheless, the image of the sheep suggests clearly what we are: defenseless before the ravaging wolf. Of all creatures, sheep possess the weakest sense of direction. So they entrust themselves by instinct to their shepherd to defend and guide them.

PRAY: Pray for God's guidance.

<u>ACT</u>: Imitate the shepherd in Ezekiel and search out the lost.
