

Pastor's Reflection



THE 4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT AND THE CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS:

We are now in the final days of Advent. Hopefully, this has been for us a time of preparation with joyful anticipation. The liturgical season of Christmas begins with the first Mass on Christmas Eve. In the

Catholic Church, Christmas is not simply a day, but a season. The Christmas season will continue through the Feast of the Baptism of our Lord which will be on Sunday, January 9th. I encourage our Faithful to maintain your Christmas spirit throughout the season. On Christmas, we remember how the light came to the earth. The Divine and Eternal Son of God was born in time. He came to reconcile sinful humanity to the Father. He came to recover what had been lost through sin and rebellion. He is our Savior, the promised Messiah.

It is my hope that the joy of Christmas will help to transform the darkness of this world and bring a spiritual renewal to the sorrowful, the grieving, the ill and the poor. It is my hope that many will rediscover their Faith and that they will return as active members of the Church.

Let us all pray for peace in the coming year.

The following is from a Christmas homily of Pope Francis:

«The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them, light has shined.» (Is 9:1)

«An angel of the Lord appeared to the shepherds and the glory of the Lord shone around them.» (Lk 2:9) This is how the liturgy of this holy Christmas night presents to us the birth of the Savior: as the light which pierces and dispels the deepest darkness. The presence of the Lord in the midst of his people cancels the sorrow of defeat and the misery of slavery, and ushers in joy and happiness.

We too, in this blessed night, have come to the house of God. We have passed through the darkness which envelops the earth, guided by the flame of faith which illuminates our steps, and enlivened by the hope of finding the "great light"

[...] Through the course of history, the light that shatters the darkness reveals to us that God is Father and that his patient fidelity is stronger than darkness and corruption. This is the message of Christmas night.

«Un ángel del Señor se les presentó [a los pastores]: la gloria del Señor los envolvió de claridad.» (Lc 2,9) De este modo, la liturgia de la santa noche de Navidad nos presenta el nacimiento del Salvador como luz que irrumpe y disipa la más densa oscuridad. La presencia del Señor en medio de su pueblo libera del peso de la derrota y de la tristeza de la esclavitud, e instaura el gozo y la alegría.

También nosotros, en esta noche bendita, hemos venido a la casa de Dios atravesando las tinieblas que envuelven la tierra, guiados por la llama de la fe que ilumina nuestros pasos y animados por la esperanza de encontrar la «luz grande». 
Come out and play the fastest growing sport in the US!

Based on the book *After the Boxes are Unpacked,* this is an opportunity to meet others, exchange insights, and find the courage to put down roots all over again.


