CELEBRATING 75 YEARS OF THE LITTLE WAY



OUR PARISH PATRONESS & PARISH ANNIVERSARY:

In Catholic teaching, the Faithful may render veneration to the Saints and humbly request their intercessory prayers. The Saints are those members of the Church Triumphant in the glory of heaven. They are close to the Lord. Their

lives are remembered for holiness and virtue. Each year during the preparation for Confirmation and in the R.C.I.A., our candidates reflect on the lives of the saints as they discern a patron saint for the sacrament of Confirmation. Our candidates will actually be called their saint's name at the time of anointing with the Sacred Chrism. We should all be mindful of the lives of the saints and we should strive to follow their example.

I think that we are mindful as well of the importance of anniversaries. I have often told people who ask about my birthday that it isn't really a big deal for me. I don't ask for any recognition or gifts on my birthday. Personally, I place much more significance on the date that I was ordained to the priesthood. That is my preference to celebrate. My ordination was a new beginning for me in this sacred vocation.

Earlier this year, we noted that our parish was officially founded 75 years ago. As it was still in the midst of the Covid crisis, we decided that we would actually celebrate our anniversary in conjunction with the Feast of St. Therese, which is celebrated on the first of October. Of course, the parish has had a rich history over these 75 years!

Most parishes are placed under the patronage of a saint. Our parish was (eventually) placed under the patronage of St. Thérèse of Lisieux. I believe that it is helpful to recall her holy life and of our call to follow the lives of the saints.

At a young age, St. Thérèse felt the call to religious life. After several attempts, she was finally accepted into the Carmelite Order at the age of 15. It is all part

of providence that a humble nun who died at the age of twenty-four would write a journal, *The Story of a Soul*, that would be translated and read throughout the world. She would also be named the co-patroness of France with St. Joan of Arc, and also a co-patroness of foreign missions with St. Francis Xavier.

For five years, I served as the diocesan director of the Pontifical Mission Societies. Some years ago, I participated in a Mission Dinner in Manhattan on the feast of St. Therese that raised more than \$200,000

for the missions. The national director was able to coordinate a tour that included the writing desk of the good saint and it was present at the dinner, a true relic. That small wooden lap desk was one of the few possessions that the sisters were permitted to have. That small box became an instrument that opened a window to her heart and her teachings to the world. Through her writings, she revealed her joys, her sufferings and how she had a desire to serve as a missionary to

bring souls closer to Christ. Without ever leaving her monastery in Lisieux, she reached the ends of the earth through her prayers, correspondence, journal and support for missions throughout the Church. She saw her vocation as "to love" and desired "to save souls and pray for priests." Prior to her death at such a young age, she wrote, "I want to spend my heaven doing good on earth." *The Story of a Soul* is a Catholic classic and may be found online electronically for free or as a book or on CD's to buy. There is a copy here in the Carolina Catholic Corner beside the St. Ignatius Day Chapel. St. John Paul II named her a Doctor of the Church in 1997 meaning that her teachings are sound and worthy of our study and reflection.

Please know that all are welcome to the parish anniversary celebration next weekend. Please see the schedule in this bulletin.

NUESTRA PATRONA PARROQUIAL Y ANIVERSARIO PARROQUIAL:

En la enseñanza católica, los Fieles pueden rendir veneración a los Santos y pedir humildemente sus oraciones de intercesión. Los santos son los miembros de la Iglesia triunfantes en la gloria del cielo. Están cerca del Señor. Sus vidas son recordadas por la santidad y la virtud. Cada año, durante la preparación para la Confirmación y en nuestro programa de adultos, nuestros candidatos reflexionan sobre la vida de los santos mientras disciernen un santo patrón para el sacramento de la Confirmación. Nuestros candidatos serán llamados por el nombre de su santo en el momento de la unción con el Sagrado Crisma. Todos debemos tener presente la vida de los santos y debemos esforzarnos por seguir su ejemplo.

Creo que también somos conscientes de la importancia de los aniversarios. A menudo le he dicho a las personas que me preguntan por mi cumpleaños que en realidad no es un gran problema para mí. No pido ningún reconocimiento ni obsequio. Le doy mucha más importancia a la fecha en que fui ordenado sacerdote. Esa es mi preferencia para celebrar. Ese fue un nuevo comienzo para mí en esta sagrada vocación.

A principios de este año, notamos que nuestra parroquia fue fundada oficialmente hace 75 años. Como todavía estaba en medio del declive de Covid, decidimos que realmente celebraríamos nuestro aniversario junto con la Fiesta de Santa Teresa, que se celebra el 1 de octubre. ¡Por supuesto, la parroquia tiene una rica historia durante estos 75 años!

La mayoría de las parroquias están bajo el patrocinio de un santo. Nuestra parroquia fue (eventualmente) colocada bajo el patrocinio de Santa Teresa de Lisieux. Creo que es útil recordar su vida santa y nuestro llamado a seguir la vida de los santos.

Santa Teresa sintió muy joven el llamado a la vida religiosa. Después de varios intentos, finalmente fue aceptada en la Orden Carmelita a la edad de 15 años. Todo es parte de la providencia que una monja humilde que murió a la edad de veinticuatro años escribiera un diario, La historia de un alma que sería traducido y leído

en todo el mundo. También sería nombrada copatrona de Francia con Santa Juana de Arco, y también copatrona de misiones extranjeras con San Francisco Javier.

Durante cinco años, me desempeñé como director diocesano de las Obras Misionales Pontificias. Hace algunos años, participé en una Cena Misionera en Manhattan en la fiesta de

Santa Teresa que recaudó más de \$ 200,000. para las misiones. El director nacional pudo coordinar un recorrido que incluyó el escritorio del buen santo y estuvo presente en la cena, una verdadera reliquia. Ese

pequeño escritorio de madera era una de las pocas posesiones que se les permitía tener a las hermanas. Esa pequeña caja se convirtió en un instrumento que abrió una ventana a su corazón y sus enseñanzas al mundo. A través de sus escritos, reveló sus alegrías, sus sufrimientos y cómo tenía el deseo de servir como misionera para acercar las almas a Cristo. Sin dejar nunca su monasterio en Lisieux, llegó a los confines de la tierra a través de sus oraciones, diario de correspondencia y apoyo a las misiones en toda la Iglesia. Veía su vocación como "amar" y deseaba "salvar almas y rezar por los sacerdotes". Antes de morir a una edad tan temprana,

escribió: "Quiero pasar mi cielo haciendo el bien en la tierra". The Story of a Soul es un clásico católico y se puede encontrar en línea electrónicamente de forma gratuita o como libro o CD para comprar. Hay una copia aquí en Carolina Catholic Corner al lado de la Capilla del Día de San Ignacio. San Juan Pablo II la nombró Doctora de la Iglesia en 1997, lo que significa que sus enseñanzas son sólidas y dignas de nuestro estudio y reflexión.

Sepan que todos son bienvenidos a la celebración del aniversario de la parroquia el próximo fin de semana. Consulte el horario en este boletín.


SEASON OF THE BUTTERFLY MIGRATION BY KELLI OLSZEWSKI

Years ago, over a decade, when the kids were small and we were on one of our yearly vacations to Hilton Head, it was a week of more rain than sun. After two and a half days stuck inside a 525 square foot

condo with three young children, at the first sight of the evening sun emerging from the clouds, the kids and I were out the door! As my husband offered to make dinner, I sat on the observation deck watching the kids run off some built-up energy. I was fortunate to strike up a wonderful conversation with an older couple from Ohio who were regular vacationers to Hilton Head too. As one of my girls chased after a butterfly, they informed me if I ever have the chance to visit in late September to early October to do so to see the migration of the butterflies. They said it was a marvelous sight. Though I never doubted them, I thought it was a far-off reality.

Last year, celebrating our 24th wedding anniversary and first time away from the kids, we headed to Hilton Head for the weekend. After an early morning bike ride on the beach and sitting on the same observation deck 12 years later, I encountered that far-off dream: the migration of the butterflies. The flutter of butterflies everywhere was tranquil. As I watched them dancing from bush to bush and listened to the waves in the foreground, it was such an inviting moment to escape into a peaceful bliss and yet remember a moment of squealing children who delighted in discovery during our beach vacations.

As peaceful as it is watching, the soft but sharp pain in the back of my throat appeared along with a few droplets of tears of momentary melancholy mixed with nostalgia as I



recall a season from yesteryear; one filled with three young children who filled and captivated many moments of my day with life lessons, exhaustion and yet so much joy and love. Just like these butterflies who are experiencing a season in their own journey, my husband and I too have reached a new season in our marriage to enjoy the gift of each other as almost empty nesters and rediscovering the beauty of our life together in ordinary moments.

Arriving at St. Therese for the second time, just in a different role, I find myself being reintroduced to the world of parish ministry and religious education, one that is both familiar and yet refreshingly new. I am older and wiser and in a different phase of life as a catechetical leader. Maybe some of you too have changed jobs, become empty nesters

or sent your youngest little one off to kindergarten. Whichever season we are in, it is an opportunity to redirect ourselves, especially in our faith. During a recent parish ministry leadership meeting, inspirational speaker, Fr. Tom McCarthy, said, "Our life is a journey. When we stop moving, things go wrong. Always journey in the presence of the Lord." His words resonated. As I thought of the fluttering butterflies taking moments to rest, they truly never remained in one spot.

As St. Therese embarks on its 75th Anniversary, its rich history of growth and change echoes Fr. Tom's wise words. The parish is never stagnant, always journeying in the presence of the Lord.

To the parish of St. Therese: many blessings—and much movement—on the next 75 years.
