ALL SAINTS & ALL SOULS:

The first of November is the Solemnity of All Saints. This year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation as it falls on Monday. We will have two Masses on Monday: 9:00am and 7:00pm. The Saints of Heaven are known as The Church Triumphant. Pope Gregory IV

ordered the Feast of All Saints to be universally observed on November 1 in the year 835. It is a day when we thank God for welcoming men and women to share in His holiness and heavenly glory as a reward for their faithfulness. The saints have shown us that saintly living is possible. We venerate their memory, we trust in their intercession; and their Christian witness inspires us. We know that we have no lasting home in this world. Heaven is our hope and our goal. In Faith, we may say that the saints have gone 'home' to the Lord. Life is a pilgrimage from this world to eternal life.

On November 2, we will celebrate the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). The feast reminds us of our Lord's victory and the promise of eternal life for those who have died in the peace of Christ. R.I.P. is a common abbreviation in cemeteries. It represents the phrase: "*Requiescat in pace*" or "*May he or she rest in peace.*" This, of course, is the prayer of the Church. The prayers of the Mass humbly ask for the happy repose of the souls of those who have died. The Mass for All Souls Day actually follows the format of a funeral Mass. The month of November is a traditional time for visiting the graves of our loved ones who have been called from this life. They are missed and yet not forgotten. We continue to love them and those souls are in our prayers throughout November. If you desire to have a Mass intention offered for the eternal rest of a loved one or friend, please stop by the parish office during office hours. We will have Masses on November 2 at 9:00am and 7:00pm in the church.

Es una Solemnidad en honor a todos los santos cristianos. Los santos del cielo son conocidos como La Iglesia Triunfante. En el año 835, el Papa Gregorio IV ordenó que la Fiesta de Todos los Santos se observara universalmente el 1° de noviembre. Es un día cuando damos gracias a Dios por sus santos que nos han demostrado que la vida santa es posible. Sabemos que en este mundo no tenemos una casa permanente. El cielo es nuestra esperanza y meta. En fe podemos decir que los santos han ido a la "casa del Señor." La vida es una peregrinación de este mundo a la vida eterna.

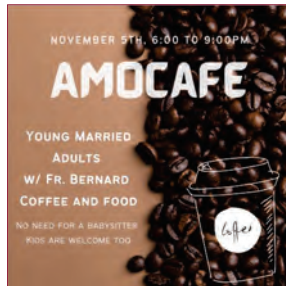

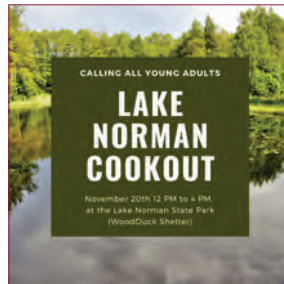

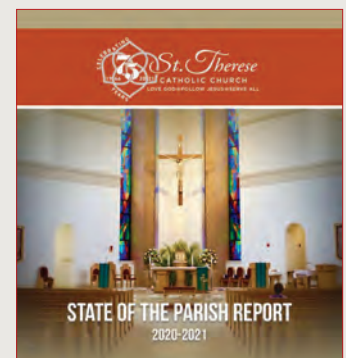
