COLLECTION FOR THE RETIRED PRIESTS:

Next weekend, we will have the special Second Collection for our retired priests who have served in the Lord's vineyard for many years. We should keep in mind that our retired priests said, "Yes" to God. They also said, "Yes" to their

bishop as they accepted various assignments. We should support them with grateful hearts. Our parish has been assessed \$47,817 of the 1.5 million dollar diocesan budget to support our retired priests. The diocese also contributes to the retirement accounts of the religious order priests that serve in the diocese. The assessment for each parish equals 3.5% of the previous year's offertory and is equivalent to about twice the regular Sunday offertory. Let us work together and make the full assessment.

Under the current diocesan policy, a priest may choose to retire from a parish assignment at the age of 70. While there may be a desire to retire from the administrative and office duties, most of our priests remain active in ministry as long as they are physically able. Bishop Emeritus Bishop Curlin passed from this life at the age of 90 in 2017. He was active in ministry for all the years after his retirement at the age of 75, especially in the pastoral care of the sick and in celebrating Confirmations. 26 diocesan priests receive retirement

benefits from the diocese and there are 23 religious order priests for whom contributions will be made. Amazingly, the ordained ministry of our retired priests totals more than one thousand years. I have decided to donate \$600.00 for this annual collection. I know that I need to support my brother priests who have served with such dedication and devotion. Fr. Thomas Clements was my pastor when I was an altar server more about 50 years ago in Salisbury. He was assigned to Sacred Heart in Salisbury for the second time while I was a seminarian. As a priest for more than 66 years, he lives his retirement at the Maryfield Community in High

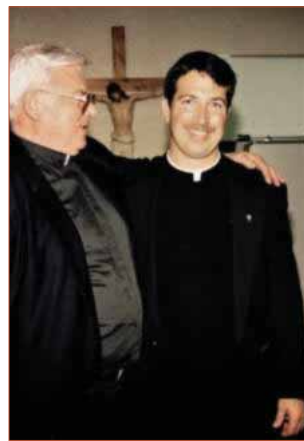
Point. He was a great mentor for me. I sometimes accompanied him on pastoral visits while I was a seminarian and I learned a lot from him. He was very kind to me when I was newly ordained and I often concelebrated a weekday Mass with him on my day off. He was extremely gracious to our family at the time of the deaths of my sister and mother. I greatly appreciate his priestly witness. Msgr. Richard Bellow was the pastor of several parishes in the Diocese of Charlotte and now lives on his own in Davidson, while remaining active in ministry. He has assisted many time here at St. Therese.

SACERDOTES JUBILADOS:

El próximo fin de semana, tendremos una segunda colecta para nuestros sacerdotes jubilados que han servido en la viña del Señor durante muchos años. Debemos tener en cuenta que nuestros sacerdotes retirados dijeron "Sí" a Dios. También dijeron "Sí" a su obispo, ya que aceptaron varias tareas. Debemos apoyarlos con corazones agradecidos. Nuestra parroquia ha sido evaluada \$47,817. del presupuesto diocesano de 1,5 millones de dólares para apoyar a nuestros sacerdotes jubilados. La diócesis también contribuye a las cuentas de jubilación de los sacerdotes de órdenes religiosas que sirven en la diócesis.

La evaluación para cada parroquia equivale al 3.5% del ofertorio del año anterior y es equivalente a aproximadamente el doble del ofertorio regular del domingo. Vamos a trabajar juntos y hacer la evaluación completa.

Bajo la política diocesana actual, un sacerdote puede elegir retirarse de una asignación parroquial a la edad de 70 años. Si bien puede haber un deseo de retirarse de los deberes administrativos y de oficina, la mayoría de nuestros sacerdotes permanecen activos en el ministerio mientras estén físicamente capaz. En 2017, el Obispo Emérito Mons. Curlin pasó de esta vida a la edad de 90 años. Fue activo en el ministerio durante todos los años posteriores a su retiro a la edad de 75 años, especialmente en la cuida pastoral de los enfermos y en la celebración de las Confirmaciones. 26 sacerdotes

reciben beneficios de jubilación de la diócesis. Sorprendentemente, el ministerio ordenado de nuestros sacerdotes jubilados asciende a más de mil años. He decidido donar \$600.00 para esta colecta anual. Sé que necesito apoyar a mis hermanos sacerdotes que han servido con tanta dedicación y devoción. El Padre Thomas Clements fue mi pastor cuando era monaguillo hace 50 años en Salisbury. Fue asignado al Sagrado Corazón en Salisbury por segunda vez cuando era seminarista. Como sacerdote por más de 66 años, vive su retiro en la comunidad de Maryfield en High Point. Fue un gran mentor para mí. Algunas veces lo acompañaba en visitas pastorales cuando era

seminarista y aprendí mucho de él. Él fue muy amable conmigo cuando fui recientemente ordenado y a menudo concelebraba una Misa entre semana con él en mi día libre. Él fue muy extremadamente amable con nuestra familia en el momento de la muerte de mi hermana y mi madre. Agradezco mucho su testimonio sacerdotal. Msgr. Richard Bellow fue el pastor de varias parroquias en la Diócesis de Charlotte y ahora vive solo en Huntersville, mientras se mantiene activo en el ministerio. Él ha ayudado

muchas veces aquí en Santa Teresita.

Sean generosos en su apoyo a la colecta especial para nuestros sacerdotes jubilados.

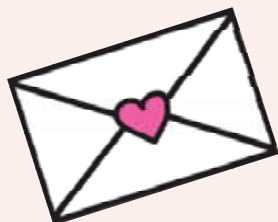

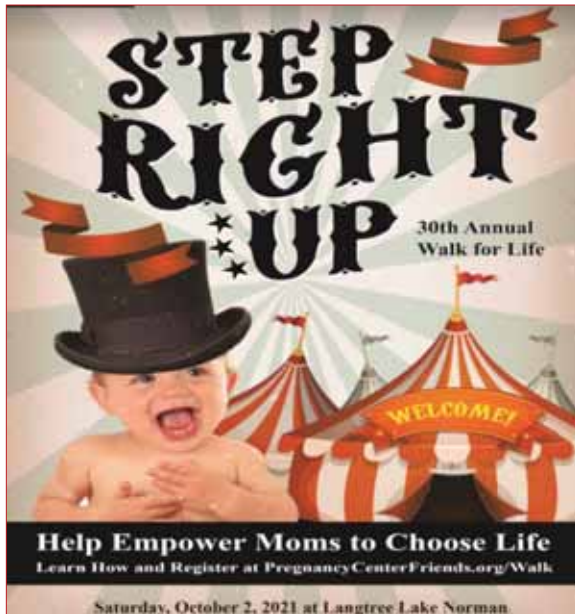

Quick and Easy Ways to Make Mealtime Prayer More Meaningful

Imagine, for a moment, a family gathering around the dinner table. Believing that the food on the table is a blessing from God, the family takes a few moments to pray, to thank God for the goodness He has shown them in providing nourishment for their bodies. They've said this prayer a thousand times before—and perhaps that's why it sounds so rushed, so uninspired, so forced. Sound familiar?

In any family, each person probably has a particular form of prayer that's most meaningful to him or her. Honor that by letting each individual choose a different prayer for the meal at least once a week... and have some fun with it. Here are just a few ideas:

- **Sing the traditional Grace Before Meals prayer**—improvise the melody.
- **Say a prayer chain**—go around the table and let each person tell God something he or she is thankful for that day.
- **Read a passage from Scripture**—don't worry about having to add anything to it. Let the verse be the prayer.
- **Take 15 seconds of total silence**—letting each family member pray to himself or herself. You may be amazed at how powerfully prayerful a pause can be!
- **Move the prayer from before the meal to after the meal**—simply changing when you say the prayer can help people focus more on the act of praying.

By mixing up the ways you pray at the table, you can ensure that habit won't trump heart. In the process, you'll discover again the joy of meeting God in mealtime prayer!

Cannonball Moments

Several weeks ago we learned that

St. Ignatius was struck by a cannonball during the Battle of Pamplona in 1521. This event was life changing for him. Many of us too, have had *cannonball moments* in our lives. Moments of anxiety, sadness, fear or pain when we wonder why these things are happening to us or our loved ones. We are so caught up in fear and darkness that we feel abandoned. It is truly hard to see God's love and gentle caring at these times. In fact, we might even get angry with God. Why me?

Why my loved one?

We pray. We look for the solutions or an out-come that we want. We

hear that no prayers are unanswered (Mark 11:24)—but we believe our prayers aren't. Could it be that we have ignored God's plan which is so much better than the one we are hoping for? (Isaiah 55:8-9)

Oftentimes, only in looking back over a *cannonball moment* do we realize how close God was to us at that time and how His plan has made us stronger spiritually.

Our faith has deepened.

Our Trust made stronger.

Take some time this week to think about the cannonball moments in your lives. What have you learned from them?

Stewardship... a way of life

Jesus points the way



Imagine yourself walking with Jesus and the disciples. Jesus has just told them that he will be handed over to those who would kill him, and that three days after his death, he will rise. The disciples did not understand him, and did not know how to ask what he meant. They drop back a bit, following Jesus and talking among themselves. Rather than discussing his confusing words, however, they begin to banter back and forth about who among them is the greatest.

Wait, you might think. They're missing the point! They were physically following Jesus, walking just behind him on the road. But they were far from following his way, the way of mercy, forgiveness, and love. When they arrived at the house in Capernaum, Jesus asked what they were

arguing about. Their silence was telling. In that moment, they knew they had strayed, even though they were so close in proximity to him. Jesus' response rings in our ears, as it must have for those who heard him that day: *"If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all."* In reflecting on what Jesus taught, Saint James realized that we must be "be doers of the word and not hearers only." James knew that we have a tendency to remain complacent and inactive, telling ourselves in our heads that we are people of faith, but not allowing Jesus' call to love and service to have an impact on our lives.

It isn't only the disciples on the road with Jesus who miss the point. We miss the point sometimes, too. We become focused on self, stuff, and success rather than on God and others. Even with the pandemic still a

concern, we may have lost sight of what we learned from our shared experience of it. Lessons such as how much more we need each other than the constant striving to be first or to come out ahead that so often consumes our time and attention.

Jesus points the way. It is the way of humble service, sacrifice, and compassion. The early communities of believers knew this so deeply they called themselves followers of the Way. Following Jesus calls us to take all he did and taught to heart, so that our way of life will be the Lord's way of self-giving love.

Every day provides an opportunity to serve another, often simply and quietly with little notice by the people around us.

Saint James tells us that if we do not take these opportunities and act on them, we delude ourselves into thinking we are Christians, yet we fail to do as Jesus commands. Our actions must reflect our faith and be a response to Christ's call. For some of us, being the "last of all and the servant of all" comes naturally easily; for many, such living is a real challenge.

Let Jesus point the way. ■

Sacrifice is a word that many of us don't like to hear.
