

Sacrament of Marriage


Contact Fr. Tim at least nine months in advance, and before committing to a date. At least one member of the engaged couple should be a registered member of the parish.


Prayer to St. Joseph



Lent is a time for many traditions at St. Gabriel. On Shrove Tuesday we 'buried the Alleluia' for the Lenten season, with students in all grade symbolically placing a caterpillar in a chrysalis for the next 40 days. On Ash Wednesday all grades, 4K - 8, attended Mass.

During Lent students in grades 3-8 will have an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and our second graders will make their first Reconciliation. Eucharistic Adoration, Stations of the Cross, and almsgiving through Catholic Relief Services' Rice Bowl also will be Lenten activities at St. Gabriel. We will conclude our Lenten journey on Holy Thursday with a Living Stations of the Cross presentation by our eighth graders.

We are blessed beyond measure to celebrate this most special time of the liturgical year as a school community.



Christian Formation



Dear Friends in Christ,
Last week I began a Lenten series of reflections on the 5 sessions from the recently released archdiocesan document, The Gift of Sunday.

The second session in the document is titled "Sunday is Natural and Intentional".

Perhaps this is best expressed in the context of the Creation story from the book of Genesis. God spends the first six days creating, and on the seventh day, He rests. Seems very intentional to me, and part of the overall plan God has for the natural world and its benefit...

This becomes most significant in light of the Resurrection stories in all four Gospels, and the Hebrew weekly cycle. In the Hebrew

tradition, the Sabbath, the 7th day of rest, is Saturday. That makes Sunday the first day of the week, as it still is reflected on our modern calendars.

Matthew, Mark, Luke and John are all in agreement that Jesus' rising from the dead occurs on the 1st day of the week. In a sense, God is "re-creating" the universal order of nature. Just as God spoke and light was made on the 1st day of Genesis, now the Light of Christ, risen from the grave, initiates a new dawn of Life for all of Creation. This also seems very intentional in the plan of God for our salvation.

The day of Sunday itself has to be firmly tied to routines that keep it from getting swept away by the tide of a continual pace of new activities. As Creation began on the 1st day, and the world was re-created as Jesus rose from the dead on the 1st day, just so the early Christians, and we, in our time,

oblige ourselves to observe the 1st day of the week as the day to gather and celebrate Eucharist, the Mass, the memorial of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. The strong obligation to attend Mass compels us to bend our day around God rather than trying to bend God around our day, and in so doing, we ourselves are re-created, as the Lamb of God proclaims so boldly in the Book of Revelation: "See, I am making all things new..."




