





Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

Happy Father's Day! Wishing you all the best on this special day. Today we also celebrate Holy Trinity Sunday. The readings focus on the mystery of God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

This last week on my day off I visited a church south of here. I was on my way to do some bicycling so I was not dressed in my clerics; however, I wanted to find a church to enter and to pray my office (the daily prayers of a priest). As I entered I noticed that the church was setting up for a funeral. The funeral was not scheduled to start for another hour-and-a-half so I had time to pray prior to the service. The people in the church were kind, but I got the sense that they were a bit puzzled by my presence. I think my youth, my attire and the fact that I was praying seemed completely out of place. But why is it strange for someone to enter a church to pray?

When I was studying overseas, it was common to enter a church at any time of the day and to see people kneeling in prayer. However, here in our diocese it seems guite rare. We need the witness of prayer. If you have a hunger to spend more time with God and you are at a stage in your life where family and work obligations are minimal, please be encouraged to visit a church during the day. Spend five minutes, half an hour, or longer. Just simply gaze at God and let him gaze back at you. The busyness of life is often a block to hearing God, but silence in prayer opens us to God's glory and is an amazing witness of strength to our community.

Sometimes we may wonder what to do in prayer. These five words could be used to provide a start: Praise, Thank, Ask, Confess, Listen. A heart close to God, is a heart that is transformed by grace. Open the scriptures, pray a devotion, or just sit in silence. Spending time with God always leads to blessings. Please let me know if you ever need the church opened for prayer. I would be happy to accommodate. Please keep me in prayer as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
