

# Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, in Latin Corpus Christi. We as Catholics center our worship around this the greatest of gifts. At the Last Supper Jesus raised bread and said "This is my Body." He then raised a cup filled with wine and said, "This is my Blood." In this moment Christ instituted the priesthood and the Holy Mass. By these words of Christ, the Passover meal was forever changed. No longer would it center around the eating of a Passover lamb in commemoration of the Exodus from Egypt. Rather it would now be the very participation of the offering of Jesus Christ, the true Lamb of God, to the Father. It would be the perfect sacrifice to end all sacrifices. It would proclaim to the end of time the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. So significant was this moment that Jesus at the conclusion of the Last Supper spoke to the apostles and said, "Do this in Memory of Me." Thus from the very beginning, the apostles (and the bishops and priests who followed them) have maintained the practice of the celebration of the Holy Mass. By partaking in Mass we are fulfilling the words of Christ. There is no higher form of worship.

The sacrifice we see in Mass is to then be lived out in our life. We are called to give our lives for the good of others, just as Jesus gave his life for our salvation. This last week I spent Sunday to Wednesday with 100 Hispanic youth. We were on retreat. One of the talks in particular was utterly moving. A veteran of the Iraq war spoke about the tragedy of war, the many close calls on his own life, and the death of his friends. Yet through all this he saw God's protection and providence. Thank you to those who serve and sacrifice for our freedom. We are never to take our freedom for granted. This last Saturday I was in La Crosse and present for the ordination of two of our new priests. These two young men freely committed themselves to a life of service to Christ and his Church. A life lived for others is a life that bears fruit. It is a life that participates in the life of the Trinity and reflects the perfect offering of Christ to the Father, which we celebrate at every Holy Mass and commemorate in a special day on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi.

Please keep me in prayer as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!


