Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

I grew up in a parish very similar to our own three small parishes. In my hometown parish we had about fifty families. Through this small community we learned about Jesus and fostered relationships of faith.

The many blessings I experienced in my hometown parish allowed me to see the Church as a place of community and encounter with Christ. However, it was not until I entered seminary that I began to see the universality of our Faith and how integrally close we are bound to the apostles and through them to Christ through apostolic succession. Growing up I knew that we prayed for the Pope and believed in his authority. I also knew we had a Bishop and that he visited our community every other year for Confirmation. But beyond this my understanding of the universal Church was quite limited.

Now that I am a priest I see everything from a different angle. I see how vital the diocese is and how important our Bishop is in guiding our local parish. I am frequently visiting the diocese and value greatly it's support. However, the importance of the diocese goes far deeper than administration. At its core the diocese is what links us to Christ himself, since our Bishop who administers the parishes within our diocese follows in the direct line of apostolic succession.

In the past three weeks I have travelled to La Crosse to visit the Diocese on four separate occasions. Last week myself, Lawrence Anibas, and Marcel Kujak attended a very informative conference on cemeteries. A week prior, myself, along with other priests and deacons of our diocese, attended an excellent conference addressing the misuse of technology in the area of sexuality. As I write this column I am waiting to enter the Bishop's residence for a bi-monthly meeting of priests on the Presbyteral Council. Following Masses this weekend, I will again join our Bishop, along with twelve other young priests for our quarterly meeting of Junior Clergy.

Every time I visit the diocese and greet our bishop I am reminded of our direct link to the apostles and to Christ himself. This knowledge assures me that Christ is always close and that we as a parish cluster are carrying on the work that he started some two-thousand years ago when he walked the Earth in the flesh.

Please keep me in prayer as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
