

Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

This last Monday we celebrated the feast of Saint Charles Borromeo. In 1569 he was shot while kneeling at an altar in prayer. The assassin was not more than five yards away. All thought the saint was dead. But upon reflection they 'found that the shot had not even pierced his clothes, but some of the shot had penetrated to the skin, and where the ball had struck a slight swelling appeared, which remained through his life.'

This same divine protection was afforded to Pope St John Paul II when on May 13, 1981 he was shot in St Peter's Square. 'One bullet hit the pope's abdomen, the other hit the left elbow. But experts analyzed the trajectory and said that they must have come from two different points of origin.' By John Paul II's assessment, 'It was a mother's hand that guided the bullet's path.' Both he and St Charles Borromeo forgave their would-be assassins.

Violence, however, has sadly been a part of our human story. We see it in our country and also this week in the sad report of a three mothers and six children being killed in Mexico. Our first reading from this Sunday shares one of the most tragic stories recorded in Scripture when a mother and her seven sons each lose their lives because of their unwillingness to deny their faith.

The Sacrifice of the Mass is the participation in the saving mysteries of Christ. It is here that we encounter the reality of death in meditating upon Jesus' own suffering. However, in this suffering we glimpse an even greater reality, that of the Resurrection and its triumph over death. "For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death." (1 Cor 11:25-26) The stories of St Charles Borromeo and Pope St John Paul II give us a glimpse of the victory we have in Christ. Death is a reality, but Christ's Resurrection is greater. Our faith allows us to participate in this Resurrection, where even death itself has no more power. Therefore, keep the Faith. Keep it strong, especially in tough times.

Please keep me in prayer as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
