Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

The priesthood is a vocation with many beautiful and unique spiritual relationships. The first is as a Father. This is far more than just a title. Just as a father nourishes and provides life for his family, a pastor is called to minister and provide Christ to all of his parishioners. This is accomplished through Word and Sacrament. As a priest I am both a father and a brother. They are the spiritual relationships that truly give life and joy to my vocation. Why? Because in these relationships Christ is shared. This is the font of true joy. Wherever Christ is shared, true joy enters in. Please keep me in prayer as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes!
