PRAYER & WORSHIP

Dear Fellow Parishioners of the Oneida Catholic Parishes,

This advent, I am asking us to reflect upon, seek and experience the healing that only God can give. In our world of technology, we are accustomed to modern medicine handling so many of the illnesses that plague us. If we do not find help in traditional medicine with its medication, surgery or therapy; we are looking more into healthier living or other alternatives. We know deep down that any form of health care can help in some ways, but not in all ways.

The healing of the heart is something that needs more than modern practices can do on their own, even if we attend counseling, only we can open to healing in our heart and that is best done with the help of God. We believe that only God in His grace can truly heal the heart, the mind, spirit and soul. Our faith is primarily in a God who heals our hearts, and our relationships with ourselves, others and God.

Let us begin by reflecting on the healing we need and the way in which we can receive it. The most traumatic experiences which lead to the deepest wounds can only be healed by love and ultimately only the love of God. We know that whenever we have been most disconnected, down and out of sorts, someone's love was the only thing that healed us. The problem with being wounded is that it hurt so much from the very beginning, we are hesitant to trust anyone enough to open to the love that they offering, and that goes for God as well. We are often content to be the walking wounded for much of our lives, only living up to part of our potential as children of God.

I invite us to change that way of living during this advent season by taking the time to know, understand, experience and seek healing for the woundedness of our whole life. Whenever we resist necessary beneficial change, lovingly accepting of other people or our own seeking to be the best person we can be

at whatever age; we are acting out of woundedness and not love. When we act out of love, we are always ready to respond as Jesus did by living our best lives, meeting people where they are, truly listening to them without judgment and affirming them as the person that they are. The more we judge, criticize and mainly look for the problems in people and the world around us; the more that we are not dealing with the parts of ourselves that need to be healed by God's love. Let us follow the advise of Jesus and the example of the holy people in the gospels by letting go of fear and allowing God to be God for us while we are who we are, warts and all, so that God can truly work to heal us.
