The two men dressed in white in today's First Reading are asking us the same thing today that they asked the Apostles, "why are you standing there?" Waiting for the whoosh doesn't mean standing around and doing nothing.

The Apostles were active as they waited. They didn't know when the moment of grace, the whoosh, would come, but they knew they had to continue to do Our Lord's will.

He promised them power when the Holy Spirit came, but they were already at work.

Sometimes we don't want to do anything until we perceive a whoosh: a boost of grace, some insight into Our Lord's will.

We must remember that, in faith, we know the floodgate of grace is open and we are being soaked in it. He's given us the sacraments, the Scriptures, and the help of the Church.

We have plenty of grace to get to work.
