P.S. Sorry! There was no letter last week because I was late for the deadline day. (They do keep me busy here!)

My Dear Family of St. Therese,

Advent is a time of anticipation. We anticipate and await the Lord's return. (And we all know what it is like to anticipate a return). But what keeps us going is the hope of the arrival – faith. The word for the week is “**ATTACHMENT**”.

An attachment to a person involves my trust. As children we should have a **secure** attachment to our parents. This means that we can depend upon them to nurture and be present. If the parent for some reason departs, the secure attachment has faith that they will return.

Sometimes our attachment may be **anxious**. Nervous and worrisome - fear of the loss of the relationship.

A **dismissive** attachment means we are indifferent to the relationship – we can take it or leave it.

What is our attachment to God, to Jesus. Is it a **secure** attachment that we are confident He is always present to care and support (and will return)?

Or is our attachment to God **anxious**. As long as I am good, God will love me. I worry if I might offend Him by what I say or do and He will withdraw His love.

Or is my attachment to God **dismissive** – I can call on God when I want Him, but I do not need Him. My relationship is lukewarm – neither hot nor cold.

When we turn to God's relationship to us, what do we find ?

“I have carved you in the palm of My hand!”
“I am with you always, till the end of time.”
“Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ”.

I'd say from God's view point the attachment is **secure!**

Third Sunday of Advent

REASON TO REJOICE

Dark violet is used throughout Advent to express its character as a season of spiritual preparation for Christmas and “the coming of the Lord.” But on the Third Sunday of Advent, formerly known as *Gaudete* (Latin for “rejoice”) Sunday, rose may be added to the liturgical environment. The entire liturgy is infused with a spirit of rejoicing.

Today’s first reading and Gospel proclaim the reality of God’s saving work in our midst. Isaiah exuberantly describes the idyllic transformation of all creation as a result of God’s presence in the midst of the people. In the Gospel, Jesus connects Isaiah’s prophecy with what is happening in his own ministry. In addition to the list of healings from Isaiah (the blind, the lame, lepers, and the deaf), Jesus’ presence brings two other reasons for rejoicing: “The dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them” (Matthew 11:5).

What's new from the Desk of the Religious Education office...

We thank our 4th graders who did a skit on Our Lady of Guadalupe for the kids in the program and their parents on Monday. A job very well done kids (with lines well-rehearsed beforehand too!).

So last week we focused on Mary and Joseph and on their journey to Bethlehem. The December Dilemma: Celebrating Religious Holidays in Public Schools & the Public Square

Every December, public schools, towns and businesses, face the difficult task of acknowledging the various religious and secular holiday traditions celebrated during this time of year without crossing the line of promoting a particular belief.

The First Amendment guarantees freedom of religion to all Americans - including young school children - by prohibiting the government from endorsing any particular religious point of view while still respecting and protecting all religious beliefs.

Holiday Myths &

Facts

Myth: *Public schools cannot display religious Christmas and Hanukkah symbols.*

Fact: A public school is free to display a Nativity scene, Menorah, and other forms of religious and secular seasonal expression with the purpose of depicting the origins of the holiday.

Myth: *Public school students aren't allowed to sing or play Christmas carols.*

Fact: Students can sing and perform religious carols along with secular ones. The purpose is to teach about our society's cultural and religious heritage and allow students to perform a full range of music, poetry and drama.

Myth: *Students cannot talk about their faith and the religious origins of their holiday in class assignments.*

Fact: Schools cannot refuse to allow, punish, or give a lower grade to a student who includes a religious viewpoint in a class assignment. Far from "establishing religion," that would be displaying an anti-religious bias which is unconstitutional and infringing on the free speech of students.

Myth: *Christmas trees, Nativity scenes, and Hanukkah Menorahs cannot be displayed on public land.*

Fact: The Supreme Court has held that these have become both a secular and religious symbol and their display by a public entity does not violate the Establishment Clause.

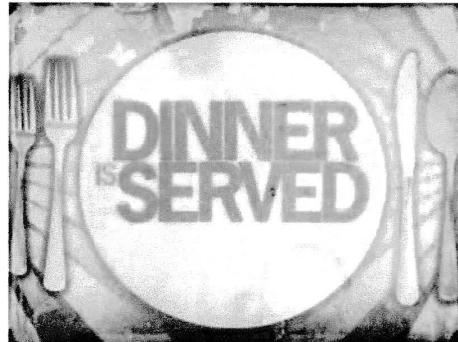
