## Pentecost Sunday

### THE RICHNESS OF THE SPIRIT

Students, and most adults recalling their school days, are familiar with the phrase “compare and contrast” that shows up from time to time on tests. Today we hear two different accounts of the giving of the Holy Spirit to the church. Let’s contrast, then compare. Luke’s account from Acts is filled with arresting details: the mighty wind from heaven, the tongues of flame, the miracle of different languages. John’s account seems timid: fearful disciples, the wounded Christ, the expelling of breath from his risen body, not from the sky. Our literal, modern minds wonder which way it happened; our noisy culture probably makes us prefer the former. But if we compare the two, we find that the dazzling richness of the Spirit fills both accounts, for it is the very breath of the risen Christ, ascended to the sky in Luke, that appears to his disciples in John and sends his followers forth to carry on his mission of forgiving sin and proclaiming the mighty acts of God.

## **Letter to parishioners on the Pentecost Sunday 2020**

For the apostles the Pentecost, like other Jewish feasts up to this point, was fulfilled in the mission of Jesus Christ. The Pentecost came as a completion of the Jewish Feast of Weeks or *Shavuot*, which was a celebration of the harvest that occurred seven weeks (fifty days) after the Passover. Notwithstanding, it was not just about the harvest but also about spiritual gifts that the people had received from God and the harvest only represented it.

As the disciples were united in prayer with the Blessed Virgin Mary “*they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim*” (Acts 2:4). We can see in this scripture passage that on the day of the Pentecost the Lord’s promise of the Holy Spirit was fulfilled. The Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples who finally gave out an abundance of spiritual gifts. It was also the birth of the Church, which was the true spiritual harvest.

For us the Pentecost Sunday closes the liturgical time of Easter. In this great feast, second to Easter, we see that it is the Holy Spirit who brings about true and lasting fruits that are showered upon the Church. As the Holy Spirit enabled the apostles to become courageous and zealous in proclaiming the Gospel to the entire world so too He enables us to become witnesses to Christ – the true meaning of the name “Christian.” We too are called by the Holy Spirit to share our faith with others who are hungry for God and the Good News. If we are baptized and confirmed, each

and every one of us without exception has received this mission of telling the world about the Salvation in Christ.

However, in order to be empowered with the gifts of the Holy Spirit, there are two conditions we need to fulfill. First, we must believe in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. Secondly, we must remain united in prayer with other believers and the Most Holy Virgin Mary. For us today it means that our faith in Christ must be put first before everything else. We also must remain united in prayer with the Church, which is the Mystical Body of Christ.

Let us pray for the spiritual renewal of the Church, through which will come about the true renewal of the world. *“Come Holy Spirit, come by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, your well beloved spouse!”*

### **Churches Reopen in Some States in Defiance of Stay-At-Home Orders**

5-20-2020: The bishops of Minnesota have permitted parishes to resume public Masses, and to defy a statewide order prohibiting religious gatherings exceeding 10 people. "An order that sweeps so broadly that it prohibits, for example, a gathering of 11 people in a Cathedral with a seating capacity of several thousand defies reason," the bishops of Minnesota's six dioceses said in a May 20 statement. "Therefore, we have chosen to move forward in the absence of any specific timeline laid out by Governor Walz and his Administration. We cannot allow an indefinite suspension of the public celebration of the Mass," the bishops added. "We can safely resume public Masses in accordance with both our religious duties and with accepted public health and safety standards." The bishops' letter permits parishes to resume public Masses May 26. <sup>(1)</sup>

"The Constitution and the rights enshrined therein are not suspended during a pandemic, and neither is our religion," said Pastor Ionescu, Romanian Pentecostal Church in Chicago.<sup>(2)</sup> A group of Romanian pastors joined a growing number of churches in Illinois and across the country by opening their churches, following guidelines, and defying stay-at-home orders, which they consider unconstitutional. The Chicago mayor had threatened, "we will take you to jail," if churches opened, reminding Ionescu of communist Romania where he saw pastors thrown into jail as criminals for preaching and gathering in ways forbidden by the government.

Liberty Counsel, representing the Chicago pastors said, "The virus doesn't prefer churches over liquor stores, or shopping malls, or big box centers, or abortion clinics."<sup>(3)</sup>

In California, 3,000 churches plan to defy shutdown orders and open on May 31 because it marks Pentecost, the birth of the Christian church, making it fitting for a "rebirth" of services. "Our churches are part of the answer, not part of the problem," said Pastor Danny Carroll. "We're an essential part of this whole journey and we've been bypassed - kicked to the curb and deemed nonessential."<sup>(4)</sup>

The shutdown of houses of worship across the country has raised questions about the constitutionality of the orders and whether they infringe upon civil liberties. Attorney General Barr has said he will crack down on possible religious freedom violations.
