Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

RADICAL TRANSFORMATION

On this Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the readings describe anything but an ordinary time. They are disturbing and they leave us disturbed. The

Old Testament reading recounts a young man's radical break with the past to follow a new path. The Gospel describes how life as we know it is abruptly changed if we follow the call of Christ. The psalm and Paul assure us that such life-altering change is possible only because of the power of God's love. We are presented with a stark choice. To love as God loves, we must leave our old lives behind. We must leave behind not just the bad, the selfish, and the evil but the ordinary, our daily work, and the important, our families, our lives. Loving as God loves requires a radical transformation, not a smooth transition.

DID YOU KNOW?

If all the Precious Blood is not completely consumed, the Minister of the cup has two options. The first (and obvious option) is to consume the remaining Precious Blood. The second option is to pour the Precious Blood down the Sacrament. This is a special sink in the sacristy (the room where things are prepared for Mass). Unlike a regular sink whose pipes go into the sewer, the pipes of the Sacrament go directly into the ground.

July 4, 1776 - A Free Nation is Born

The Great Awakening, a religious revival begun in the
1740s,
infused the colonists with a zeal for independence in
religious

practice as well as government, **thus reinforcing the
principle of freedom from religious persecution/
religious**

freedom, that brought the first settlers to America.

After nearly a year of trying to resolve their differences
with Britain concerning many
grievances together with taxation without representation
(the colonists had no say in the
decisions of the English Parliament even though they
were English citizens), in May,

1776, the 13 colonies sent delegates to the Second
Continental Congress in

Philadelphia. After nearly two months of prayer,
discussion and debate, these "Founders"

approved the **Declaration of Independence**, drafted by
Thomas Jefferson.

*"We hold these Truths to be self-evident, that all Men
are created equal, that they
are endowed by their Creator
with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are
Life, Liberty, and the
Pursuit of Happiness."*

Fascinating Facts for the Fourth:

* The first Declaration of Independence draft presented
to Congress blamed King

George III for the slave trade, which Jefferson described
as "a cruel war against human
nature itself." Georgia and South Carolina delegates
insisted the passage be removed.

* When told that George Washington would return to
private life and not remain in power
if the U.S. won the American Revolution, King George
III reportedly said, "Then truly he
is the world's greatest man."

* Three Founding Fathers and U.S. presidents died on
the Fourth of July: Thomas
Jefferson & John Adams on July 4, 1826, and James
Monroe, July 4, 1831.

* In 1776, 2.5 million new people lived in the U.S. Now,
243 years later, over 300 million
people live here.
