My Dear Family of St. Therese,

This week I begin a class in dealing with trauma in our lives. My next contact meeting is in October, so I will be here for several weeks ahead.

How ironic to have this week's Gospel of the "Prodigal Son". In the Gospel the Father awaits the son's return, in St. Therese we await the Father's return! We continue to pray for that day and trust that it is in God's hands and time! And The Monsignor continues to be spoiled in Greenport with His Aunt Mary!

In Human Development this week we spoke about Christian Love! St. Theresa of Avila said, "When one reaches the highest level of Christian maturity, one has only one question - How can I be helpful?"

To love is to live in the present moment as I ask "Am I Doing Love Right Now?" if the answer is "Yes!" than we are living as we were created to be! We know that to love in the present moment is not always easy, not always without being hurt, yet it is what we are called to do, called to be.

If we are asked, "Who's image and likeness we created in?" All of us who were taught with the Baltimore 2 Catechism would answer - "GOD'S". and Sister would be very happy because it is the correct answer.

But do we truly see ourselves as the image and likeness of God in this world? That image is not male or female. According to St. John - GOD IS LOVE! That's the image in which we were created!

LOST AND FOUND

Welcome to “Lost and Found Sunday”! Just in case being in church makes us proudly consider ourselves especially religious, today’s Gospel suggests that we’d be wiser to admit that we’re sometimes lost. Then we’ll eventually be happily counted among Jesus’ “found,” because today Jesus focuses on a lost sheep, lost coin, lost son. Jesus does so because the Pharisees and scribes, proudly considering themselves especially religious, “began to complain” that Jesus “welcomes sinners and eats with them.” So Jesus warns them—and us—to stop judging others. Marvel instead that God’s amazing grace has found us! Indeed, we should become Jesus’ friends lovingly trying to find others. So Exodus asks, if God “relented in punishment” and pardoned us, shouldn’t we forgive fellow sinners graciously? Even Paul admits his “arrogance” as “foremost among sinners.” We too, happy at being “mercifully treated,” should share with everyone else Jesus’ unfailing patience.

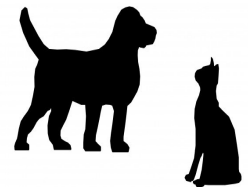

"Building a Culture of Religious Freedom"
From Abp. Charles Chaput's address on July 9,
2019

"Religious believers can live quite peacefully with the separation of Church and state, so long as it's real freedom and not the half-starved copy of the real thing called 'freedom of worship.' We can never accept a separation of our religious faith and moral convictions from our public ministries or political engagement. It's impossible. And trying to do so is evil ..."

Therefore, "religious faith sincerely believed and humbly lived serves human dignity" for both the believing and non-believing (and) "...it's vital in building a humane society."

"We can begin building a culture of religious freedom by changing the way we think. Majority opinion doesn't determine what is good and true. The deep moral problems we now face in our country didn't happen overnight. They've been fed by a false understanding of freedom for decades, and they have roots in the exile of God from public consciousness.

"We also need to change the way we act. ...The right to pursue happiness does not include a right to excuse or ignore evil in ourselves or anyone else. When we divorce our politics from a grounding in virtue and truth, we transform our country from a living moral organism into a kind of golem of legal machinery without a soul."

"If we want a culture of religious freedom, we need to begin living that culture here, today, and now ...Nations change when people change... You create the future with the choices you make. So, serve the poor. Help the weak. Protect the unborn. Speak the truth about creation (Gen. 5:2). Fight for your right to love and serve God, and for others to do the same.

"If you do that, you'll inspire others to do the same. And you'll discover in your own life what it means to be fully human."

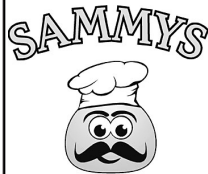
