

FATHER KRIS' KORNER



As we prepare for Christmas, the Prophet Isaiah offers us a beautiful image of a world where animals that should be enemies are living together peacefully: the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the goat; the calf and the young

lion shall browse together, and the baby shall play by the cobra's den. If only human beings could live in a world where we all live in peace; a world where we practice acceptance and tolerance, compassion and mercy, forgiveness and repentance. Unfortunately, during the holidays, there are those who dread being with some of their family members. Oh Lord, help us to put our differences aside for just one day! Oh Lord, help us to say sorry for the wrongs we have committed against our family members or friends. On this second week of Advent, John the Baptist urges all of us to "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." How quick are you to admit your own shortcomings and wrongdoings? Do you make amends for your sins by producing good fruit as evidence of your repentance? 


