Genuflecting.... bending our knee in the presence of the Eucharist is a special expression we give to the Real Presence of Christ in our midst in the tabernacle when we enter a Catholic Church

Clarification: Please keep up this special expression even though you see me and others with balance issues or knee concerns bow to show respect.

Eucharistic Minister:

****Approach the altar during the exchange of peace.

****Use the Hand sanitizer after you have received Holy Communion.

****Make your greeting: THE BODY OF CHRIST forthright.

***Should young children come up in your line; greet them with:

"Jesus loves you."

****When finished distributing, return the ciborium to the altar, stand there until the priest has closed the tabernacle. Then return to your pew.

****The pastor will communicate those needing to receive a low-gluten host. Please do not handle any of the hosts found in a pyx or special dish in the tabernacle.

Expectations for the Celebration of a Sacrament:

Sacrament of Baptism

Contact pastor to schedule class and time.

Sacraments of Penance & Holy Eucharist

Religious Education classes required for the Second-Grade students and an interview with the Pastor before celebrating each sacrament. Parent will participate in a class for each sacrament.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Faithful attendance at Religious Education classes in Grade & High School; honor all Confirmation classes and retreats, guidelines of the diocese; an interview with the pastor.



Sacrament of Matrimony

Contact pastor at least 6 months before the proposed wedding date to begin Instructions.

Sacrament of the Sick

Should you know you will be having surgery, etc. or know you will be hospitalized, or have health concerns, contact the pastor to celebrate the Anointing of the Sick.
