

## Ushers:

\*\*\*\*Hospitality is the theme of your ministry. If needed, help guests to find a place to sit.... should there be an emergency, be available for assistance... route them to the restrooms if a family seems to be looking around. \*\*\*\*Please be early...check to see that the bulletins are available.... that the security bag is on the table...and anything else that may need attention.

\*\*\*\*The Collection: little ones will bring their gifts to the priest.... when most have returned, ushers take up the adult collection. When you have finished taking the collection...THEN, HAVE PLACED a security bag on the table in the back and the TWO USHERS TOGETHER put all that is in the collection baskets in the bag...then: seal the bag; and then bring the bag to the front and lay it beside the kid's collection basket. This is really important for the protection of all who

deal with money. Any questions, please talk to Fr. Bob.

\*\*\*\*see that doors are opened or closed depending on the activity.... lights, etc. are in order.

### Expectations for the Celebration of a Sacrament:

## **Sacrament of Baptism**

Contact pastor to schedule class and time.

### Sacraments of Penance & Holy Eucharist

Religious Education classes required for the Second-Grade students and an interview with the Pastor before celebrating each sacrament. Parent will participate in a class for each sacrament.

### Sacrament of Confirmation

Faithful attendance at Religious Education classes in Grade & High School; honor all Confirmation classes and retreats, guidelines of the diocese; an interview with the pastor.



### <u>Sacrament of Matrimony</u>

Contact pastor at least 6 months before the proposed wedding date to begin Instructions.

### Sacrament of the Sick

Should you know you will be having surgery, etc. or know you will be hospitalized, or have health concerns, contact the pastor to celebrate the Anointing of the Sick.
