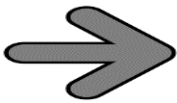

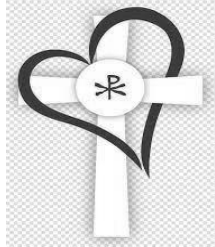
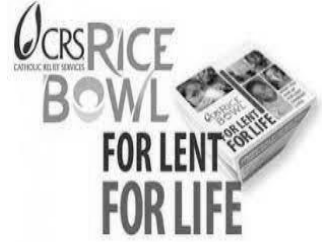

The **Feast of Divine Mercy**, is celebrated the Sunday after Easter, this year, Sunday, April 11. To prepare for this feast, pray the Divine Mercy Novena or say the Divine Mercy Chaplet daily beginning on Good Friday, April 2, and ending on the eve of Divine Mercy, April 10. On this feast Jesus pours his mercy upon us to make our souls like the newly baptized. This special grace of forgiveness of all sin and its temporal punishment is granted with the following conditions: Go to confession before or on the feast day, going during Lent is sufficient. Be in the state of grace--no mortal sin. Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday with the intention of receiving this special grace. *Do acts of mercy such as forgiving people, praying for others, and have the intention to be more merciful to our neighbors.*
