This weekend we celebrate a feast honoring the Body and Blood of Christ. Although we honor the Eucharist on Holy Thursday each year, today's feast allows us to reflect on a different aspect of Jesus' great gift to us.

Today's liturgy reminds us of the magnitude of this gift. Both our First Reading and the Gospel speak to us how the Eucharist finds its roots deep in Jesus' own Jewish heritage and its power to draw us into life with Christ. Our celebration helps us to focus beyond the Eucharistic elements of bread and wine and see how we, too, are rooted in the Jewish faith. Our sharing in Christ's most holy Body and Blood joins us to Christ's sacrifice on the cross and makes us members of God's family, a theme proclaimed in the Second Reading. As we celebrate this day and as we receive Communion today, may we thank God for the amazing way Jesus left us His presence in our lives.

It is that presence that strengthens us as we feel challenges about our faith. As the days of our merger with Saint Rocco's get closer, we need to remember that it is the Lord in the Eucharist that is first and foremost in our lives. Although we feel comfortable in worshiping in this, our parish church, it is the same Jesus we worship no matter what church building we may attend. I pray that everyone truly embraces that fact and not turn away as we move into a new reality.
