Meditation for the 32nd Sunday

"The Lord himself will come down from heaven at the word of command, at the sound of the archangel's voice and God's trumpet." —1 Thes. 4:16

Jesus is coming soon. No one knows the day or the hour. In that case, the only practical thing is to be always ready and keep our eyes open. When Jesus comes again for the final time, "those who have died in Christ will rise first". If you live near a cemetery, that will be a sight to behold! "Then we, the living, the survivors, will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. Thenceforth we shall be with the Lord unceasingly". Even though this awesome event is in the future, right now we can "console one another with this message".

Knowing he is coming will keep us working for his kingdom, dispensing the ration of grain in due time. We will "not absent ourselves from the assembly, as some do, but encourage one another; and this all the more because you see that the Day draws near". Jesus' future coming transforms the present by motivating us to love him and live for him to the full.

Become a Confirmation Sponsor for St. Joseph Parish Youth.

As the 9th and 10th graders prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation, you may be asked to take on the role of a sponsor or a Mentor. (A mentor is one who serves in place of the sponsor if he/she is not available as in the case of living many miles away.)

The following information will help you in accepting this role.

The church requires that sponsors:

-must be sixteen years or older.

- -may not be the natural or adoptive parents.
- -must be fully initiated into the Catholic Faith.
- -must be leading a life in harmony with the Catholic Faith.
- -must be free of any canonical impediment.

What is the role of a Confirmation Sponsor?

- To spiritually walk with the candidate during the preparation for the sacrament.
- To assist the young person in being a true witness and disciple of Jesus.
- To represent the community when you present your candidate to the bishop.
- To help the young person fulfill his or her baptismal promises after Confirmation.

Sponsors / Mentors are to have only one candidate. Do not say yes to more than one youth in this class. If you are asked to be a sponsor and live a long distance from Mobridge, your candidate will be asked to find a local person who will then serve as a Mentor. You, however, will present your candidate to the Bishop during the Confirmation ceremony.

Before saying yes:

- Make sure you meet all the requirements.
- Make sure you are available and willing to <u>be involved with their preparation</u> by meeting and spending time together in order to mentor them in the faith. This will involve an all-day retreat in the parish hall in January 2021.

<u>Praying for the Faithful Departed:</u> Prayer for the dead is one of the greatest acts of charity we can perform. Through our prayers, we can help the faithful departed during their time in Purgatory, so that they can enter more quickly into the fullness of Heaven. One form of prayer is to have a Mass prayed for deceased loved ones.
