## Reflexology

Reflexology is a form of massage applying deep pressure to reflex points on the feet, opening nerve pathways to increase circulation and create a sense of balance within the body. The cost for a one-hour session is \$45. and a half-hour session is \$25.


## Monona Library Friday Morning Book Group (on Zoom) Friday, June 18th from 10:00 - 11:30 a.m.

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# **GARDENING COMMITTEE UPDATE**

## Friends Group Gardening Committee



The Garden Committee of the FRIENDS of Monona Senior Center planted its <u>first</u> trees in the top tier of the Step Up Garden, a Dwarf Barlett Pear and a Dwarf Clapp's Favorite Pear from Jungs Seed and Plant Company. They also planted their <u>first</u> mail order plant and <u>first</u> bush, a Sensation Lilac from Spring Hill (deep purple blooms with white edges) in that same tier 3 garden.



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Their very <u>first</u> mail order purchase, a soaker hose, arrived in early May. All these purchases were made possible by a \$50 and a \$500 anonymous donation. The Gardening Committee appreciates donations in kind (plants, mulch, etc.).
