LENTEN FAST & ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS: Fasting (ages 18-59) is limiting ourselves to one full meal & two smaller meals each day. Abstinence (age 14 & older) is refraining from eating meat. Good Friday is a day of fast & abstinence; all Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

ITEM OF NOTE –

Because protective measures of separation and isolation by government agencies and church directives have been extended, and to prevent too much of a backlog, previously scheduled Sunday Mass intentions which were deferred will now begin to be re-scheduled for weekdays where openings allow.

- Holy Thursday – ceremony without the washing of feet
- The Commemoration of the Lord's Passion is to be celebrated in parish churches if at all possible
- The Easter Vigil should not be celebrated privately.
- Easter Sunday with a priest alone -- the Renewal of Baptismal Promises would be omitted
- “Because some of the faithful may still try to attend these private liturgies of Holy Week and Easter, church doors must be locked.....”
