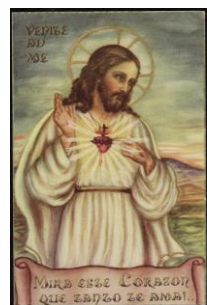

THE PRESENT AND THE FUTURE.....

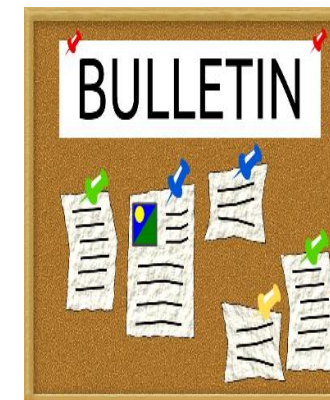
- ✓ **Daily Mass** -- Monday-Friday, 7:30 AM in Sts. Peter & Paul Chapel
- ✓ **Weekend Mass Schedule** –Sat: 4:00 PM Mass; Sun: 9:30 AM will continue as long as sanitization of the church is required. Beyond the sanitization issue the date for resumption of the usual 3 Mass schedule will depend upon how quickly parishioners return in sufficient numbers to warrant 3 Masses
- ✓ **About Weekend Mass Intentions:** we will try (however no guarantee) to honor those already scheduled Mass intentions, BUT we will not take any newly requested weekend Mass intentions until further notice

GREEN PHASE OF PANDEMIC RECOVERY: The latest diocesan directives were received Friday, June 19. It said that all diocesan directives received earlier concerning celebration of Mass and reception of sacraments, including Holy Eucharist, were to remain in place. Also all safety practices, like wearing of masks and social distancing were to continue until further notice from the CDC.
