Concerning Consolidation/Closure of Holy Family Parish

1. A four (4) member Transition Team has been formed
2. It will work with Fr. Vincent Dang along with members of a Transition Team from St. Leo
3. As of July 1 discussions began concerning the celebration of the closing Mass at Holy Family. When details of this event are finalized the date will be published. In other matters conversations with Fr. Dang touched upon combining liturgical ministries. There was also conversation about the temporalities of Holy Family Parish.
