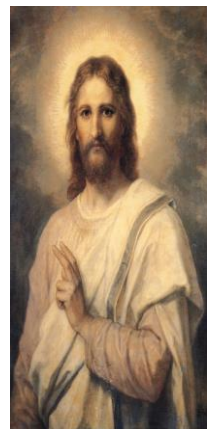

### Highlights from the latest Diocesan COVID 19 Guidelines (8-6-2021)

- ✓ Altar servers are expected to wear masks while serving at Mass
- ✓ Prior to the distribution of Communion Priests, Deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers should sanitize their hands. If there is direct contact with a person's tongue, the minister should properly sanitize their hands.

What was the territorial boundaries of Holy Family comes under the jurisdiction of St. Leo, but church Canon Law also stipulates that individuals/families/households have the right to join the parish of their choice. Although records are transferred, membership at the new parish is **NOT** automatic and **NOT** presumed.
