**ABOUT PARISH FINANCES:** Our Parish Finance Council met last week as they reviewed the 2019-20 finance report that must be submitted to the diocese every year. FYI: A) In the 4 months March 1 – June 30 the category of Sunday offertory was 7% lower than the same time period last year. B) Obviously the only extra fund raising event of the season was held last Sunday **while currently every other fund raising activity is cancelled** due to the pandemic. C) The 2020-21 proposed budget is unbalanced/underfunded in the range of \$70,000.00. D) The diocesan school assessment as of 8/1/20 is \$75,072.00 in arrears.
