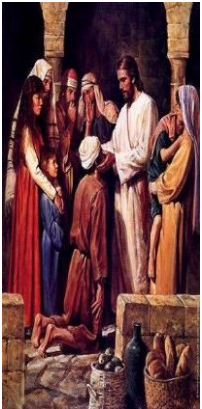

Highlights from the latest Diocesan COVID 19 Guidelines (8-6-2021)

- ✓ Masks are not mandated, but **strongly** recommended while attending Mass, regardless of vaccination status
- ✓ Priests, Deacons, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion return to wearing masks during the distribution of Communion
- ✓ Altar servers are expected to wear masks while serving at Mass
- ✓ Prior to the distribution of Communion Priests, Deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers should sanitize their hands. If there is direct contact with a person's tongue, the minister should properly sanitize their hands.

PARISH SACRAMENTAL RECORDS for all three (3) Sugar Notch parishes will be transferred to St. Leo, Ashley after the closure of Holy Family Parish.

PARISHIONERS NEED TO REGISTER: at the parish they decide to join, now or at some point in the future. What was the territorial boundaries of Holy Family comes under the jurisdiction of St. Leo, but church Canon Law also stipulates that individuals/families/households have the right to join the parish of their choice. Although records are transferred, membership at the new parish is **NOT** automatic and **NOT** presumed.
