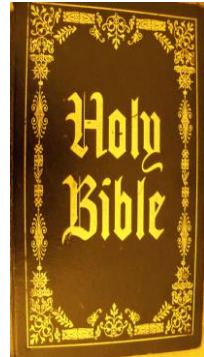

MONTHLY ROSARY: will be held **Monday, October 19 at 6:30 PM** in Sts. Peter & Paul Chapel

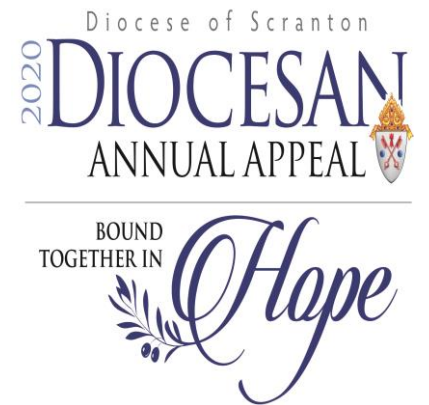


PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR): resumes **Sunday, Oct. 18, 10:30 – 11:45 AM.**

DIOCESAN ANNUAL APPEAL: The theme this year is "Bound Together in Hope". Appeal letters seeking your support will continue to be mailed to parish households. Your **Pledges** can be mailed directly to the diocesan Development Office. *Payments on these Pledges can extend to April 2021.* A video about the 2020 Appeal can be found on our parish web page. It also provides a direct link to the diocese for those intending to make their **Pledges**. As in the past, money raised in this Appeal helps fund diocesan efforts to assist soup kitchens for the poor and marginalized, catholic school education, seminary education, and care for retired priests. We ask for your charity in understanding the mission of the church and in your financial support of that mission. The diocesan goal is \$4.5 million, and **our goal at Holy Family is \$16,000.00.** If we exceed this goal 75% of that money is returned to the parish.

LATEST COVID 19 GUIDELINES RECEIVED FROM THE DIOCESE – on October 9, 2020
(As congregations assemble for Mass)

Items that Remain in Place	Changes (partial return to pre-pandemic Eucharistic celebration)
1. Hand sanitizers available for use	1. <u>Communion Rite</u> to its appropriate place in the Mass. Communicants will return to their pews
2. Use of masks to continue	2. <u>More music</u> with entrance/recessional processions, hymns, the Eucharistic Acclamation, and Great Amen
3. Social distancing maintained	3. Return of <u>liturgical ministries</u> , especially Eucharistic Ministers
	4. <u>Ushers</u> taking up regular offertory and second collections
	5. <u>Parish bulletin</u> availability at church entrances/exits at end of Mass
