+ REMEMBERING OUR VETERANS + Next Sun.,

Nov. 8th, the St. Vitus Catholic War Veterans Post 1655 will celebrate its **Annual Memorial Mass** at 9:00 a.m. at St. Vitus Church. This tradition has been observed every year for the past 71 years. At the Mass every deceased veteran of the parish is remembered, including the 43 parishioners who died for our country. Some have no one left to remember them, but at least once a year they are remembered at Mass. Please keep our fallen and living veterans in your prayers. We invite all to come and celebrate their lives and sacrifices for our country, and to join us for fellowship following Mass in the lower church hall.



MASSES FOR ALL SOULS – All Masses are being said for the repose of souls of your deceased loved ones, our deceased parishioners and benefactors. Please use the **All Souls** envelope and indicate the names and intentions you wish to have remembered in the Masses. These intentions are prayed for throughout the month of November. Additional Mass intentions are sent to other priests to be prayed.



ALL SAINTS DAY – is a glorious testimony to the ultimate Christian hope that someday we too, like the legions of saints and martyrs ahead of us, will gaze upon God with pure adoration and thanksgiving. From the earliest times of the Church, Christians have admired the heroic virtues of Christian martyrs and holy saints and sought their intercession before the Lord. It is well documented in Christian history that innumerable blessings, favors, miracles, and conversions have taken place through the intercession of saints. Before the invention of photographs, Christians sought out physical objects of saints like fragments of relics of their bodies and other objects connected with their lives. Holy Scriptures contain many instances of God bringing about a healing using material objects. In recent times, for example, there is credible evidence that when sick individuals prayed for a healing to the saintly Bishop Baraga and were touched by the Stole belonging to Bishop Baraga, they received healing which cannot be explained by medical science. Healing is always by God; relics are a means through which He acts. Relics are ordinarily housed within a sacred vessel called a reliquary. Over the years our parishioner, Christine Morsch, who died recently, acquired several reliquaries of Saints. This weekend we will have several reliquaries of the more familiar saints available for veneration: St. Clare, St. Theresa of Avila, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Vitus, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Ignatius of Loyola, and St. Christine.

In a special way we include our deceased family members, friends, parishioners, benefactors and those who have no one on earth to pray for their souls. A plenary indulgence may be gained for the souls in Purgatory on this day under the usual conditions: freedom from mortal sin, attendance at Mass and reception of the Eucharist, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. We will have two Masses on Monday: 12:00 Noon in church and at 5:00 p.m. at The Village Chapel. Please come!
